



Sylvania Schools is using the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department's guide to determine when students may return to school after exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms.

Please review the low-risk and high-risk symptoms along with the different scenarios.

This chart applies to the following:

- Student exhibits one or more COVID-19 symptoms at school
- Parent/guardian calls the school to report an absence due to one or more COVID-19 symptoms
- Student has confirmed COVID-19 exposure

The number of days a student misses is based on the symptom(s) exhibited. The chart details the criteria for returning. In the second scenario, a student exhibiting one high-risk symptom or multiple symptoms who is not evaluated by a healthcare provider or tested for COVID-19 must wait 10 days before returning to school. In this case, before returning to school the student must be also be asymptomatic and fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.

If your child has a pre-existing condition that may appear as one of the symptoms, it may be helpful if documentation from a healthcare provider is provided to the school ahead of the onset of symptoms.
