## Parents/Guardians:

This school year pricing will be as it was last school year. School meals are available to all students; however, they are not free or reduced to all students. Households may apply for free or reduced-price meal benefits at this time.

By filling out the online free/reduced meal application annually, through the National School Breakfast and Lunch Program, students may also qualify for waived or reduced school fees and other benefits. This application is based on factors such as income, household size, etc. Free and reduced meal applications must be filled out annually. If you need assistance, please let us know. Applications for the new school year are available at Sylvaniaschools.org then go to Our District, then to Student Nutrition. About half way down that page is a link to the online application.

Eligibility for free and reduced-price lunch is based on federal income guidelines or participation in other programs such as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program and Ohio Works First.
