



As Sylvania Schools continues to maneuver this unprecedented terrain combined with the various new situations that arise with each step we take, we would like to thank our parents for your patience as administrators and teachers have worked through the developing situation in Lucas County. The Sylvania Board of Education has approved that the district will begin with full remote learning for all students in August.

As all students will begin with remote learning, last evening Dr. Motley announced that the Sylvania Alternative Learning Academy (SALA) will not be in place at the beginning of the school year. All students in Sylvania Schools will have the opportunity to remain at home but also engage in remote learning alongside their peers with their regularly-assigned teachers. In effect, all students will have the same opportunity to learn from home with Sylvania teachers.

For this reason, we are deferring the SALA program for now. As the situation in our community, state, and nation develops, we will revisit all opportunities to support your children in both safety and learning, including SALA. Those developments will bring further announcements. Until then, we are excited that your children will receive the opportunity to work with Sylvania teachers in a renewed effort to make remote learning engaging and rewarding.
