

Timeline for Clay High School Scholarships

- February 24, 2023: Release the criteria for the Clay High School Scholarships/Memorials and Scholarship Application.
- March 10, 2023: Deadline for the students to return scholarship application.
- March 17, 2023: Send out applications to scholarship sources who are deciding the winner of their scholarship/memorial.
- April 7, 2023: Deadline for scholarship sources to return the winner(s) of their scholarship/memorial.
- May 9, 2023: Presentation of Senior Scholarships at 12:30pm; Gathering after presentation. End time 2:30pm

 - Available: February 24, 2023
- Go through and highlight the various scholarships that you meet the criteria for.

 - Available: February 24, 2023
 - Place a (x) next to the scholarship(s) you are applying for.
 - Attach all required documents necessary to complete the various scholarship(s)
 - The bolded titles on the application will require additional documentation; resources found in Schoology.
- Deadline: March 10, 2023 at 2:35pm to the counseling office or submitted on Schoology.

Scholarships requiring the submission of the CHS Application

BARNEY QUILTER GOOD GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

1. Applicants should be planning on a college major in Political Science.
2. Evidence of Volunteer/Experience in political activity (ex. Student Gov't).

THE BELTZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Leadership at school
2. Community activities

BETTY CARSTENSEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Worthy student who attended Jerusalem, Coy, and/or Starr Elementary

CLAY HIGH BAND PARENTS

1. Senior band members

DAWN M. BRINKMAN-BARB EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

1. Student majoring in Education.
2. Must have a minimum of five (5) credits of any combination of Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, or Biology, and a combination of six (6) credits of English and/or Foreign Languages.
3. Students whose parents are on the Oregon City School Board, or whose parents are employed by the Board, and nieces and nephews of such parents, are eligible, however, these students must be in the top ten-percent of class ranking, grade-wise
 - * If meets above and are a member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church, Woodville Rd Toledo Ohio OR Parent employed by St. Charles Mercy: applicant will have preference.

EDITH C. HARRIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Nursing/Health Profession

1. G.P.A. of at least 2.5.
2. Major in field of nursing working pursuing baccalaureate degree
3. Minimum of at least five (5) semesters at CHS, including a full senior year.
 - *If no qualified nursing applicant is found the committee may look to other qualified candidates in other health profession fields.

Engineering/Science

1. G.P.A. of at least 2.5.
2. Major in field of engineering or area of science working pursuing baccalaureate degree
3. Minimum of at least five (5) semesters at CHS, including a full senior year.

ERIC R. BRINKMAN ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

1. Student majoring in Engineering.
2. Must have a minimum of seven (7) credits of any combination of Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, or Biology, and a combination of six (6) credits of English and/or Foreign Languages.
3. Students whose parents are on the Oregon City School Board, or whose parents are employed by the Board, and nieces and nephews of such parents, are eligible, however, these students must be in the top ten-percent of class ranking, grade-wise
 - * If meets above and are a member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church, Woodville Rd Toledo Ohio OR Parent employed by St. Charles Mercy: applicant will have preference.

FONDESSY SCHOLAR

1. Financial Need
2. Exemplary Personal Qualities
3. Responsible Academic Record

GENOABANK SCHOLARSHIP

1. Seeking Business Degree at 2 or 4 year college
2. ACT/SAT
3. Community Service
4. Top 50% of class
5. Leadership and participation in school and community activities

GEORGE & ELAINE ACKERMAN SCHOLARSHIP

1. GPA of at least 3.0
2. Intent to major in agriculture or a field related to agriculture, with a lower priority given to students majoring in a field related to the environment
3. Attendance at Clay for at least four semesters
4. Involvement in extracurricular and/or community activities (i.e. athletic, musical, artistic, academic, etc.)
5. Demonstrated leadership capabilities
6. Need for financial assistance in order to pursue a post-secondary education. Students who have received a full scholarship will not be eligible.

HELEN M. RICHARDSON MEMORIAL

1. Must be planning a career in medicine or medical field.
2. Financial need will be considered.

JAMES E. SHEAHAN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

1. Seeking higher education at an accredited school
2. Former Eisenhower Middle School Student
3. Financial need
 - *The level of the parent's income will not be a disqualifying factor
4. Leadership capabilities; club president, athletic or academic leader.
5. The student has or had a job or has regular volunteer experience.

LAWRENCE & ADELE YOUNGBAUER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP –Genacross Lutheran Services Foundation

1. Will be attending an educational institution preparing for a career in a helping profession: Nursing, Ministry, and/or Social Work

LESTER COON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Worthy student who attended Jerusalem Elementary

MICHAEL CASEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Minimum GPA of 3.0. & good attendance
2. Majoring in Education or Medical Science pursuing baccalaureate degree
3. Must participate in varsity athletics at Clay
4. Each student must have attended Clay High School at least five (5) semesters.
5. Leadership capabilities

MICHAEL RUDESS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. GPA of 2.5+
2. Clay football letter winner

O.C.F.T./OREGON CITY FEDERATION OF TEACHERS FUTURE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP

1. The scholarship will be awarded based on the highest unweighted GPA.
2. Enrolling as an Education Major in a 2 or 4 year college.
3. Attended any public high school (non charter schools).
4. Son or daughter of an OCFT member*

*If no son or daughter meets the criteria for this scholarship, the following criteria shall then apply:

1. Highest GPA of a student going into Education who is the grandson or granddaughter of an OCFT member.
2. Highest GPA of the members of student government.

OREGON CITY FEDERATION OF TEACHERS PAST PRESIDENTS' SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to two Clay High seniors based on the following criteria:

1. Students will have accumulated the highest and second-highest GPA in their class
2. Attended Clay High School for five of the last seven semesters, including the current semester
3. Son or daughter of an OCFT member*

*If no son or daughter meets the criteria for either one or both scholarships, the following criteria shall then apply:

1. Highest GPA of a student who is the grandson or granddaughter of an OCFT member.
2. Highest GPA of a student declaring an education major.
3. Highest GPA of the members of student government.

Scholarships requiring more than the submission of the CHS Application

AUSTIN TAKACS ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

- 1.GPA : 3.0 or higher
- 2.Evidence of admittance to a college/university
- 3.Awarded to student with highest GPA who has not received any other CHS scholarships.

AUSTIN TAKACS BAND SCHOLARSHIP

1. GPA: 3.0 or higher
2. Evidence of admittance to a college/university in musical instrument studies.
3. Participated in marching and concert CHS Band
4. Awarded to student with highest GPA who has not received any other CHS scholarships.

BCSN CHRIS KLOSTERMAN SCHOLARSHIP

1. Intent to:
 - i. major in an international affairs related subject (such as international relations, international law or international business); or
 - ii. major in a field requiring international study; or
 - iii. study at an international university;
 - iv. study abroad or participate in an international educational exchange program
2. Demonstrates an interest in international studies, area studies, international affairs, and/or international relations and intend to pursue this interest at a post-secondary educational institution of their choice.
3. Four or more years of high school social studies classes, with a composite grade point average of B (or its equivalent) or higher in these classes
4. Demonstration of a spirited interest in international affairs as evidenced by participation in activities such as, but not limited to, student exchange programs, domestic and international travel with an emphasis on cultural education, active involvement with a sister cities' organization or Model United Nations, etc.
5. An interview indicating interest and commitment to learning about global affairs
 - * It is desirable that: a) this interview include an oral quiz covering major global events from the current school year; and b) the interview be conducted by a member of Clay High School's social studies' department faculty and a Clay High School counselor or administrator.

BCSN DENNIS SLOTNICK SCIENCE AWARD SCHOLARSHIP

1. GPA 2.5 or better
2. Major in Environmental Science or Biology
3. Four credits of science
4. Teacher recommendation
5. Short essay describing their *commitment to protect the environment*.

BEVERLY ANN WAMER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Minimum GPA of 3.5
2. Must have played 4 years of Women's Soccer for CHS
3. 1 page minimum Essay on your experience as a CHS Women's Soccer Player
4. Letter of Recommendation from a CHS Faculty Member

CLAY HIGH ATHLETIC BOOSTERS

- 1 Student Athlete must be actively involved in Varsity Sports at Clay
2. Student Athlete's parents and/ or grandparents must be active Booster Members (paid membership and active participation in at least 1 Booster activity in the previous 12 months)

CLAY HIGH LIMELIGHTERS

1. 3.0 GPA
2. Participation in 6 productions over 4 years; Participation means being in the cast or on the tech crew.
3. Essay: 500 word max. Explaining the benefit of being a part of the Limelighter's Program (excluding ANY Limelighter Advisor)
4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher who has observed the student performing
5. Provide a list your Limelighter activities with application.

CODY VANHERSETT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. 3.0 GPA
2. Must enroll in an accredited college/university & pursue a 2 or 4 year degree
3. Participated in Varsity Athletics
4. Attended CHS at least 5 semesters: including full senior year
5. Essay – prompt found in Counselor's Suite

DO SOMETHING AMAZING SCHOLARSHIP

1. Intent to pursuing a degree in either Early Childhood Education or Engineering
2. Teacher or Counselor Recommendation
3. Two Essays

GOODWILL CHALLENGE SCHOLAR

1. In a 1 page essay, provide example(s) how you have lived your life similar to the mission statement and core values of Goodwill.

JACOB FREIMARK TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. 2.5 GPA
2. Four years of participation at Clay High School in the technical work, lighting and sound, for the Limelighter productions.
3. A member of the Limelighters in good standing. This includes tech work done in a timely manner (as determined by the adult tech supervisors).
4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher who has observed the student performing (excluding CHS drama director)
5. Provide a list your Limelighter activities and verification of Tech Hours.

JAMES R. MCALLISTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. 3.0 GPA
2. Must enroll in an accredited college/university or a technical college
3. Participation in 3 years of high school athletics
4. Letter of recommendation from CHS facility member describing the student's unique personality traits and his/her activities/ participation at the school
5. Essay describing your school spirit and your hobbies/interests outside of school

JOE OLINGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Participated in Machine Trades
2. 2 letters of recommendation from CHS Staff Members
3. Essay completion

LUKAS MASON MEMORIAL

1. Played two years of football
2. 3.0 GPA
3. Complete Essay on how much football meant to you. List position in essay.

MARCIA PUNSALAN MEMORIAL

1. Must be used towards continuing education at the post-high school, collegiate level
2. Student must have a cumulative 3.5 GPA or higher
3. Top Entry of the Marcia Punsalan Memorial Scholarship Essay

OLLIE HALKA MEMORIAL

1. Career Tech Student
2. 500-word Essay describing how you will use your experience in a career tech program in your future endeavors.

OREGON JERUSALEM HISTORICAL SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP

1. 2-3 Minute video of applicant portraying a historical figure **or** a 250-word essay explaining interest in historical events
2. Must enroll in a college, university, or technical program
3. Service Form – found in Counselor's Suite

OREGONIAN CLUB

1. GPA of 2.75+
2. Vocational or Academic course of study
3. Resident of the City of Oregon
4. Type and amount of community service student has performed. Student must have participated in at least one community oriented service activity or project. The Oregonian Club Student Citizenship Scholarship Community Service Form must be attached to your application.
5. Additional information is required- see The Oregonian Club Activity Sheet
 - * Other grants/scholarship awards to be disclosed.

PATRICK BARTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. Outstanding male and female student who attended Eisenhower/or Fasset M.S.
2. Participated in sports in either Jr. High or High School
3. Submit 1 paragraph on how athletics have impacted your life for the better

RYAN KERSEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. GPA of 3.2 or higher
2. Played two sports while at Clay (does NOT have to be at the varsity level)
3. Essay – prompt found in Counselor's Suite

TOLEDO SWISS SOCIETY

1. GPA of 3.0
2. The student must be college bound
3. The student must have had a year of foreign language
4. The student must have participated in either NHS, Student Council, or Athletics
5. The student shall be a US Citizen

VIRGINIA & WARREN WILKINSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. A combined ACT and G.P.A. of 23.5 or higher.
2. Financial need is a primary consideration. The family income must not exceed the O.I.G. limits (approximately \$36,000).
3. A copy of the student's SAR report from FAFSA is required.
4. The student must have attended Clay at least five (5) semesters.

VOLUNTEER FOCUS SCHOLARSHIP

Must have volunteer hours/community service record & attached to the application.

The following are the different levels of scholarships you can apply/qualify for:

1. 100+ volunteer hours during your four years at Clay High School will qualify you to apply for a \$1,000 scholarship
2. 75-99 volunteer hours during your four years at Clay High School will qualify you to apply for a \$750 scholarship
3. 50-74 volunteer hours during your four years at Clay High School will qualify you to apply for a \$500 scholarship
4. Enrolled in an accredited university /college
5. Must be a Volunteer Focus member with good attendance at meetings
6. Leadership capabilities: examples such as: Club President/leader, active in athletics/captain, academic leader
7. Short one paragraph typed statement about "Why volunteerism is important to you."
