Old Business:

- Raise Right:
 - Printer Discussed potential donation (tax write off?). Lindsey Wolf will look into whether the Community Center would want it
 - o 111 remaining gift cards (\$2,350 value). Discussed offering at a discount. Will start with 10% off. Ideally would like to off load by the end of year. Melinda will ask Valerie for a list of remaining cards. Will advertise and will offer cards for sale at the band banquet and at all of the upcoming band/choir winter concerts. Alicia and Kristi will offer them at the Candy Gram table. Approved by majority vote.
- Upcoming Booster position openings for 26/27 season (volunteer now to learn the ropes and formal vote will take place in spring) -Discussed need for increased visibility/clarity.
 Alicia will create a write up about all positions and send it out to all music parents via Square.
 - Uniform parents marching band (2) and concert attire (1) significant discussion surrounding urgent need for concert uniform support for fitting, recording sizes and assembling uniforms. If support cannot be found perhaps Wind Ensemble will switch to student provided black top and bottom for concerts (like 7th, 8th, and Symphony Band). Discussed potential for parents to come in after hours to fit/find tuxes/dresses, or discussed requiring families to provide their own tux/dress (and having Boosters sell the ones we have to families). It was decided that choir will need to find their own uniform person to help them with the quick turnaround time that was requested (1 week).

- Winter Program registration
 - Budgets

It appears Boosters cover the cost of senior night flowers and the senior gifts given at the marching band banquet.
