- -CONTENT: Students will learn the importance of being honest.
- -ALERTS: Students will reassess the way they live out their faith.
- -APPS: Students will commit to being honest about their faith.

BIBLE PLATFORM: : Job 2:1-10, 3:1-11, Job Tested (NIV)

LESSON OVERVIEW: The Christian life is not an easy one. Christians have just as many ups and downs as anyone else, but they have God to carry them through. God wants us to have an honest faith so that we can show others the difference that God makes.

LESSON CHALLENGE: We don't do ourselves or anyone else a favor by saying, "Everything's fine," when everything is not. Our challenge is to be honest about the ups and downs in our lives so that people can see how God carries us through good times and bad.

YOUTH LEADER FEED:

When someone asks how we are, the stock answer is, "I'm fine." But how often are you really fine? While we don't need to burden everyone with our problems, we do need to be real with others when it comes to matters of faith. Life is challenging, and we do ourselves and others a disservice by pretending it's not. Be honest about your life and your faith so that you can be a witness to God's power.

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

BIBLE PLATFORM: : Acts 7:54-60 (NIV), The Stoning of Stephen

LESSON OVERVIEW: The people in the world of Divergent want everyone to fit into one of five categories, but not everyone fits into one faction. God doesn't want us to allow ourselves to be bound either. He wants us to have a faith without boundaries or limits

LESSON CHALLENGE: There are people who want to put Christians in a box, to contain them and keep them bound within a church. God wants us to have a faith that cannot be contained, that is boundless.

YOUTH LEADER FEED:

How would you hold up under persecution? If you were put on trial for your faith, would you stand up under the pressure?
