-Tuesday, April 28: Chapters 8-9 Vocabulary. Go to dictionary.com and look up each word. Record the definition of each word.

-Friday, May 1: Plot Structure Chart. A plot structure chart details the exposition (beginning), rising action (events that create suspense), climax (highest point of interest), falling action (when the main issue is resolved), and resolution (the ending). This is similar to the timeline assignment we did for *Invisible Man*. You must provide quotes to support your answers.
