What are the Qualifications?

In order to run for the Board of Education, a candidate must be:

- A U.S. Citizen
- a qualified voter of Holley Central School District;
- at least 18 years of age; and
- a legal resident of the District for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least 30 days.

What do you do if you are interested in serving?

- A little bit about yourself
- Why you want to be a school board member
- What you think are the top issues facing the district

How Long is the Term?

A normal term is three years. Since this resignation is in the middle of a term, the board will appoint an individual to serve until the next regular election on May 21, 2024.
