Title I - Part C

#### Purpose of Title I - Part C

- 1. Ensure that migrant children have access to the same educational opportunities as other children.
- 2. Help migrant children overcome barriers to education.
- 3. Help migrant children graduate from high school and be prepared for postsecondary education or employment.

#### Migrant... not "Immigrant"

## A migrant worker, or migratory agricultural worker is someone who:

- 1. Seeks agricultural employment of a seasonal or temporary nature.
- 2. Typically makes multiple interstate or intrastate residency changes to follow the qualifying work.

\*A person's citizenship status is not a factor for qualifying for the Title I-C program

#### Federal Definition of a "Migrant Child"

## For Title I-C eligibility, a migrant child must...

- be under the age of 22 years old.
- not have graduated from a U.S. high school.
- not have earned a GED.

#### Basic Eligibility Criteria for Title I-Part C

#### Both Statements must be true:

1. Family must have moved into the school district sometime in the past 36 months,

#### and

2. Someone in the family must have engaged in "Qualifying Work" sometime during those 36 months.






