WCPS Lottery Schools include the following:

Wayne Early/Middle College High School (WEMCHS)* is located on the campus of Wayne Community College. Current **8th** grade students may apply to attend WEMCHS for grades 9 - 12. The goal at WEMCHS is to prepare students to be college-ready, work-ready, and life-ready upon graduation from high school.

Wayne School of Engineering (WSE) is located on the campus of Goldsboro High School. Current **5th** grade students may apply to attend WSE for grades 6 - 12. WSE is an autonomous school within a school, and students have the opportunity to receive a personalized education with a focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM).

Wayne School of Technical Arts (WSTA) is located on Seymour Johnson Air Force Base. Current **5th** and current **8th** grade students may apply to attend WSTA. WSTA offers a STEM-themed education, providing students the opportunity to earn the AP Capstone Diploma Endorsement and/or industry credentials in a technical arts field of study.

Student Lottery Procedure

- Information regarding qualified applicants will be sent to a research agency, “SERVE,” which is affiliated with UNC-G, for lottery selection process. Information will include:
 - Directory level information (name/birthdate)
 - School assigned to attend (to ensure equitable representation)
 - First generation/under-represented population status (WEMCHS applicants)
 - Military connected parent information (WSTA applicants)
- SERVE will upload submitted student list to SECURE computer file accessible ONLY to research team members involved in lottery process.
- Student data, including name, birthdate, and whether or not student was selected in the lottery will be sent to the North Carolina Education Research Data Center at Duke University.
- Data is de-identified and assigned a number for any future research so that students’ names are never specifically used in any research.
- Past (and possible future) use by UNC-SERVE of de-identified data includes studying the academic success of students selected to attend a CIHS vs those who were not selected in a lottery.
- There are currently NO plans to use data from Wayne County Schools’ students in research.
- Should SERVE desire to use student data in future research:
 - ONLY de-identified student data will be used
 - This de-identified data will ONLY be used with the approval of the Institutional Review Board of SERVE, as well as a formal approval from Wayne County Schools.
