POSITIVE SCREENING/K-12 STAFF

Employee has a temperature $>100^{\circ}$

OR

Exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19 that are new or unusual:

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell • Headache • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches



Employee will remain or be sent home and referred to family's health care provider.



Alternative or No Diagnosis

To return to school, employee must be free of new and unusual symptoms and obtain:

An evaluation document from health care provider AND one of the following:

A lab-confirmed negative COVID-19 test result.

OR

10 days have passed since onset of new and unusual symptoms.



Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Test Result

The MCDPH will place employee in isolation, which lasts a minimum of 10 days.

Employee can return to school after being released from isolation by the MCDPH.
