# Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES Test to Stay (TTS) Program

## December 2021

**TTS Purpose:** to allow asymptomatic, unvaccinated students who were exposed to COVID-19 to continue in-person learning while in mandatory quarantine.

### **TTS Eligibility:**

Students will remain in the TTS program while they continue to meet the DOH definition;

- the student is symptom free
- the school has received consent for the student to undergo daily testing, and
- the student tests negative on each school day for seven (7) days after exposure

\*Test to Stay process will be discontinued at such a time that student becomes symptomatic or tests positive for COVID-19

#### **TTS Protocols:**

- Reporting all COVID-19 test results, including TTS results, to the New York State COVID-19 report card
  - Results will be reported via NYSDOH COVID Dashboard by Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES
  - Daily test tracking sheets will be submitted to designated ECLRS reporter
  - Results will be reported to NYSDOH via ECLRS within 24 hours of testing
  - Parents will be notified of results each day (email or text if negative, called if positive)
- Process to ensure equity so that all students are eligible for TTS
  - TTS will be provided at no cost to all students at their school/program
  - Students will arrive to school via the school bus & will return home via school bus, if negative
  - Students will be tested at their morning location of learning
- Obtaining consent for testing from students' parents/ guardians and setting forth process for obtaining such consent
  - Written consent, via email or text
  - Verbal consent from parent documented by tester on consent form
- Designation of individuals who will conduct the testing and individuals who are responsible for reporting test results
  - BOCES 2 nurses (RN's/LPN's)
  - School District's Designated staff

- Contracted Nurse testers
- All test results will be reported to the designated ECLRS reporter by the testing nurse.
- Test to Stay testing will be conducted at school, in designated area as determined by District and/or BOCES 2 Program Nurse. All testing will be performed at school to ensure accuracy
- Testing Process and protocol for addressing results
  - Testing will take place upon student's arrival at school/program
  - Testers will follow FDA BinaxNow Step by Step Procedures
  - o Student will:
    - Remain in second designated area (TBD) until test results interpreted
    - · Receive test results in private

### If test result is negative:

Student will go to class

If test result is positive, Tester will:

- Follow current protocol for a positive screen as per established district protocols
  - Escort student to isolation room,
  - Notify Program Nurse if not tester, who will call parent/guardian to pick up student
  - Notify Program Administrator and BOCES 2 COVID Coordinator
  - Testing will be paused at that location until area has been cleaned and disinfected; misting by O&M staff
- Quarantine Requirement: Parents will be informed that an exposed student who is allowed to remain in school through TTS remain quarantined outside of school instruction/academic periods. School-sanctioned activities (sports, clubs, etc.) after school, on weekends, and holidays are <u>not</u> permitted.
- Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES will follow local health department on contact tracing outside of school. BOCES 2 COVID Coordinator, Building Administrator and/or designee will initiate contact tracing within the classroom setting. BOCES will collaborate with component districts and local Departments of Public Health when contact tracing involves shared students.
