- Implementation of a standard response protocol adopted from the "I Love U Guys" Foundation
 - Periodic safety drills conducted with faculty and students
 - Mandatory IDs for faculty and students continued
 - Periodic safety discussions with faculty and students
 - Continuation of character development

OUTCOMES

- Partnership with first responders, staff, and students resulting shared common language, training, and expectation of behavior during a crisis
