Class Rank:

• Indicate that your high school does not report class rank.

Grading Scale:

- 4.0 scale, weighted.
- Your QPA may be above a 4.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Teacher Recommendations:

 <u>Do not</u> invite teachers to complete recommendations through Common App or Coalition App. <u>Request</u> teacher letters of recommendation through Naviance.

Counselor Recommendations:

Does your school require a counselor letter of recommendation? <u>See the Counselor Letter of</u>
 <u>Recommendation Form on our website or in the Counseling Office for directions.</u> There is no way to request a counselor letter of recommendation in Naviance.

Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR):

- Some schools ask for, or require, a student to report their own grades, rather than send in a transcript (ex: Pitt, Penn State).
- If you are self-reporting your grades, stop in to see, or email the counseling office administrative assistant, to request a copy of your transcript. Use your transcript to complete the SRAR.
- Input every class and grade as it appears on your transcript.

Transcripts:

 If a school requires an official transcript from SF, log into your Naviance account to request the transcript. Directions for requesting transcripts can be found at https://www.southfayette.org/CollegeApplicationResources.aspx

• SAT/ACT:

- Send your SAT/ACT scores to the schools you are applying to by logging into your College Board/act.org
 account, select to send scores, and add all schools where scores should be sent.
- Typing in your SAT/ACT scores on the application is not sufficient (unless the school indicates that you can self-report your scores. Please call the admissions office if you are unsure).

Deadlines:

- Be aware of application deadlines. Even if a school has rolling admissions (application stays open your entire senior year), they still may have a deadline to submit the application in order to be considered for scholarships!
- Request transcripts and letters of recommendation <u>at least two weeks before a deadline.</u>
