

Information for 10th and 11th Grade Students

- The PSAT exam will be administered on Tuesday, October 31, 2023.
- **The PSAT is now digital. Test-takers must bring their fully-charged laptop and laptop charger on October 31st.**
- Students who do not bring their device will not be permitted to test.
- Testing will begin promptly at 7:20 am. Students arriving after testing has begun will not be permitted to test, per College Board policy.
- Bussing will be provided for test-takers on test day.
- Test takers who do not report for testing will be marked absent.
- Testing room information will be shared with students prior to test day.
- A calculator will be available through the testing software which students will use to complete the exam. Students should still bring a pen and pencil with them on test day.
- Parkway students in grades 10 and 11 are expected to take the PSAT and will be excused from Parkway on October 31, 2023.

After the Test

- Students who would like to leave at the conclusion of testing can do so with a signed permission form (found below). **Permission forms must be submitted to the Counseling Office by Friday, October 20th.**
- Students who remain at the school can complete any asynchronous work they may have. Students will participate in lunch, and will receive bus transportation home at normal dismissal time.
