 - Research the latest information technology (IT) security trends
 - Prepare reports that document general metrics, attempted attacks, and security breaches
 - Develop security standards and best practices for their organization
 - Recommend security enhancements to management or senior IT staff
 - Help computer users when they need to install or learn about new security products and procedures.
