WHY?

- ACCESS ED was developed in response to COVID-19 for families not comfortable allowing their child(ren) return to the classroom
- Offers a completely remote learning experience
- Synchronous & asynchronous lessons
- Students will attend their same school

WHEN?

- ACCESS ED Remote Learning Program will be available to families eligible to attend Asheboro City Schools for the 2020-2021 school year
- Application window opened July 15, 2020
- Students may transition back to the F2F classroom via a written request from a parent/guardian

HOW?

- Complete the enrollment form by August 1, 2020, to maximize scheduling
