Principal Update (Jason)

- Rising 5th grade parent meeting will be held February 22 via Webinar. A 30 minute session will be held prior to the general session for those students utilizing special education services and 504 accommodations.
- Experiential "Field Trip" Learning Opportunities:
 - -7th and 8th graders have completed interest surveys and staff are looking through data.
 - -The goal is for a 7th grade experiential day trip within central Ohio and 8th graders may may have the opportunity to venture outside of the central Ohio area.
 - -The hope is for an end of the year 8th grade celebration excursion to potentially Kings Island.
 - -6th graders will have the opportunity for an outdoor day experience at Camp Mary Orton in the early spring. The camp can accommodate 40 students/day so students will participate in sessions throughout a week's time.
 - -The goal, this year, is to utilize funds from the D.C. trip school account to off-set the trip expenses.
- Jason, staff and teachers have a continued focus on student well-being, mental health, and student and behavioral skills.
- Birdie Light Presentation On February 23, Beth Weinstock, parent of a former Bexley student who passed away from a fentanyl overdose, will speak to MS/HS parents about the opioid epidemic and fentanyl awareness.

President Update (Jill)

- Cookies for Dr. Fine's Visit: Dr. Fine spent a day in the middle school office to be available to middle school staff and teachers to answer questions, hear concerns and to learn what is going well. The PTO provided cookies for Dr. Fine to share with staff and teachers.
