Completion of Health Forms

- You will receive an individual link in an email to access the kindergarten registration forms. The health forms will be included.
- You will be asked to upload your child's immunization records.
- You can also mail, fax, or drop off a copy of the immunization records at the elementary school.

- These forms need to be completed by your family doctor and dentist.
- They must be dated after September 1 the previous year
- Both exam forms can be submitted at any time during the kindergarten school year.



All immunizations must be completed prior to school entry and they must be properly spaced.

- 4 doses of the tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis vaccine (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of the <u>polio</u> vaccine (4th dose must be given after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose)
- 2 doses of the MMR vaccine (measles, mumps, and rubella)
- 3 doses of the <u>hepatitis</u> vaccine
- 2 doses of the <u>varicella</u> vaccine or a written statement from a doctor indicating immunity

Check with Your Pediatrician

Please check with your child's pediatrician to ensure that your child receives all of their immunization doses (properly spaced) prior to the start of kindergarten.

Please have your child's doctor complete the lead testing form and return to the health office by 12/1/2022.

Medication

- School personnel is not able to diagnose, provide, or prescribe any medication for a student.
- Medication shall include all pills, drugs, and medication prescribed by a physician and any over-the-counter medicines.
- No herbal remedies will be given during the school day.

Medication (continued)

- Medication needs to be given at home during non-school hours.
- However, if it is essential for medication to be administered at school, it must be accompanied by a written request signed by both the physician and parent/guardian.
