

A Message from Mrs. Montgomery

Our fabulous SS Philip and James, K-3 teachers, invited me to participate in "Read Across America". The first week in March emphasizes the importance of reading daily to all children across the country. I love reading and as a former teacher know the importance of reading every day. This wonderful invitation inspired me to think about one of my favorite children's stories; There was an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Fly written by Rose Bonne. It is a nonsensical story of an old woman who swallows increasingly large animals in the attempt to help herself with a problem of accidentally swallowing an insect. I loved the rhythm and rhyme of this sing-song story as a child, never really thinking about the real issue in the tale. Why didn't anyone help the old woman? As an adult I now wonder why the woman is left to correct the problem herself? "When God's people are in need, be ready to help them. Always be eager to practice hospitality." (Romans 12:13) Human beings are social creatures that rely on cooperation to survive and thrive. People, young and old want to be in the company of friends or family and share our lives with them. We want to talk about the minutiae of our lives: what we had for dinner, the trip to school, what is packed in our lunch, as much as we do about the big things in our lives. Lent is a time to slow down, notice

and connect. Like the old lady in the story, we need to be noticed. We long for a deeper connection with our family and friends. You still have 32 days of Lent to improve. One way to slow down, notice and connect during Lent is by giving up a less productive activity in order to say "yes" to something more meaningful, and life-giving. Perhaps you give up 30 minutes of screen time and replace it with 30 minutes of in-person, face to face time. Just think how the ending of The Old Lady Who Swallowed a Fly would be changed if just one person was around to help.
