


Free Lunches for the Rest of the Year!!

(Ok, only until the end of 2020)

The Ohio National School Lunch Program is helping to provide free lunch for all students from tomorrow until December 18, 2020. Here is what is needed:

- Using the lunch form provided for the month of September, fill out the days your child/children want lunch. (If you already turned this in, but are adding days, please fill out a new form)
- Turn the form in without money to your homeroom teacher. In October, November, and December repeat the process.
- Milk will be provided with lunch at no cost. Milk purchased without a lunch is still \$0.50.
- For families that already paid for September lunch or have credit from March, your credit will be applied to lunches in January 2021.
