Humbled by Your Generosity

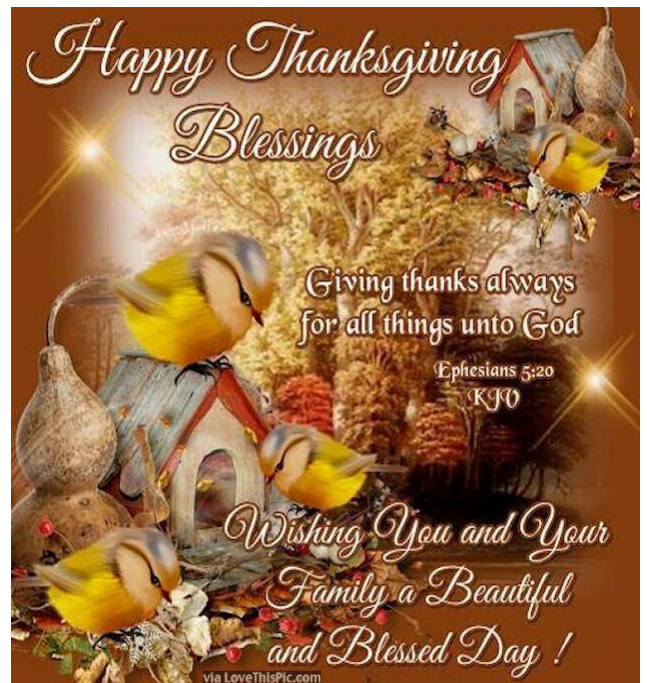

Contingency Plan

Dear Regina Coeli School Families,

I want to thank everyone for their continued efforts in helping our students stay in school. The students and staff have done a phenomenal job in following the safety protocols. However, I am well aware of the growing number of cases and hospitalizations throughout the state and local communities, so I ask that you continue to do your part outside of school so our students can remain in school.

To quell any rumors, we do NOT plan to go remote after Thanksgiving break, and we are planning to continue in-person learning in the building before and after Christmas break.

With that being said, we are developing CONTINGENCY plans for building closure because of the spread of COVID-19 within Stark County. As we work through our plans, I ask you to formulate your own contingency plans should it become necessary for a grade level to be quarantined or the building to close. If we are required to transition to remote learning, it will be done as a safety measure for the staff and students, and the decision will not be made lightly. Specific instructions and details will be provided before any transition would occur.

Please do not hesitate to reach out with questions. Our families, students, and staff have done a remarkable job thus far, but we need to continue to work together to practice social distancing, mask-wearing, and handwashing in order to keep school and communities safe. We are all in this together.
