In 2020-2021, SPJ students were provided with a great deal of tuition savings through several avenues, including Youngstown Diocesan Catholic School Scholarships, SPJ Parish financial assistance, the EdChoice and EdChoice Expansion Scholarship, Be a Student's Friend, Stark County Catholic School Alumni Partnership Scholarships and SCRIP.

EdChoice Update

NOTE: The FY 2022 Expansion Application System is now open and the forms are available on the EdChoice website. However, the Traditional EdChoice list and guidance materials will not be available until closer to the Traditional EdChoice System opening on March 2, 2021.

**EdChoice Expansion eligibility was recently changed to 250% of federal poverty guidelines. The EdChoice Expansion Income Guidelines document on the EdChoice website has been updated to reflect this change.

Renewal Forms are being mailed to <u>all</u> current scholarship parents. Blank application forms, Income Verification Form and additional information have been posted in the scholarship system as well as on the Ohio Department of Education / EdChoice Website.





A New Program for 2021-2022

New to SPJ for next school year 2021-2022, will be an option for our early learners- Transitional Kindergarten. SS Philip and James Transitional Kindergarten program provides children an extra year of growth before beginning a full day Kindergarten. This extra year of "childhood" enables children to continue to develop their social, emotional and academic skills. The curriculum follows the Ohio Learning Standards and is accredited by the Ohio Department of Education as a half day Kindergarten. All children must be five years of age by September 30th to attend. This will be a great opportunity for first time learners and students with a summer birthday!
