Do you respect life? I think that everyone's life should be loved no matter what disability or disease they have. God created everyone the way he wanted them to be. God always has a plan. This makes me think of my older cousin Jonathan. He was born with a disability called Cerebral Palsy.

Cerebral Palsy affects body movements and muscle coordination. They have difficulty walking, bodily functions and coordination. Fewer than 200,000 per year are diagnosed. It cannot be cured. It's due to abnormal brain development before birth.

Jonathan is a twin but his brother, Joseph, died in their mom's belly so the doctors had to hurry and get Jonathan out. Jonathon was born in 1990 so he'll be 32 this year. He had surgery on his legs to help him walk better. Since Jonathan has Cerebral Palsy he is not active but he is in the process of writing a book. He has two dogs. I like him no matter what he looks like or if he has a disability or not. They sometimes come to our house for special occasions. We pray, talk, catch up with what's going on, and hang out with each other.

I think Jonathan should live because he is a human like everyone else. Since Jonathan has Cerebral Palsy doesn't mean he deserves to die. If Jonathan has enough love for us then we should have enough love for him. God created everyone in the image God wants them to be. Disability or not I love him no matter what happens. When we get hurt God helps us. When we are having a bad day God helps us. Life is hard but God is always there in the dark and when something bad happens he is always there with you no matter what.

Respecting life is when you feel it, not just say it. Respecting life is when you keep it in your grasp and not throw it away. Life is the thing you keep in your heart no matter what's going on. We should live by the golden rule which is treat others the way you want ro be treated. God always has a greater plan waiting for us in the future.


# Fourth Grade Goes Virtual Thank you, Canton Art Museum
