

Self-Reported Transcript and Academic Record Tip Sheet

The STAR (self-reported transcript and academic record) is a part of the college application that requires applicants to input their classes, grades, and credits from high school. Students should consult with their colleges to learn if a STAR is required as a part of the admissions process. Students should refer to a copy of their transcript when completing the STAR.

South Fayette High School Information

- We use a weighted, 4.0 GPA Scale
- We do not provide rank
- We use a numbers and letters grading system (letters are only used for pass/fail classes)
- We use a 0-100 grading scale
- 65 is the lowest passing grade

- When entering classes, be sure to write the name exactly as it appears on the transcript

- Middle school classes do not need to be included on your STAR, as no high school credits were earned for middle school classes
