

BCI Student Drop-off/Pick-up Information



- Exiting right onto Upper Bellbrook? Follow the red arrow path.
- Exiting left onto Upper Bellbrook? Follow the yellow arrow path.



BMS Overview

- First period: 7:50am; students permitted into the building at 7:20am
- Dismissal is at 2:50pm
- Drop-off loop: Pull forward to the last light post



BMS Student Drop-off/Pick-up

- Use the drop-off loop and NOT the parking lot or west end of the building
- Do not pass other cars in the drop-off loop










BHS Student Drop-off/Pick-up

NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN FOR STUDENT DROP-OFF/PICK UP 2019-2020



- 1. Students may be dropped off at 4 locations: North, South, Front, and Back lots
- 2. Students may enter the building, beginning at 7:15am, through the front, side, library, and Freshman Hall doors (White arrows).
- 3. No one is permitted to drive behind the building.
- 4. Beware of students in crosswalks.
- 5. Drop off early and pick up late to avoid traffic.
- 6. School is in session from 8am-3pm
