Diploma Distribution-May 21st

*Individual diplomas will be distributed to each student in the CHS gymnasium walking across the stage the same as our traditional graduation ceremony. Please arrive at the designated times below according to the first letter of your last name. We will be taking necessary safety precautions including wearing personal protective equipment, practicing social distancing and providing sanitation stations. It is recommended for all students and family members in attendance to please wear personal protective equipment such as masks and gloves. Students and their families may only include **up to 5 guests per graduate** as to follow the guidelines of our local health officials to not exceed the number of people considered for a mass gathering. If you choose not to participate in this event, your diploma can be picked up any time after May 26th during normal office hours at CHS.*
