EASTERN WAYNE HIGH SCHOOL Late Arrival / Early Release Agreement

Dear Parents & Students:

Read the following information before signing the agreement at the bottom of this page.

Some students may need only a few classes their senior year to complete graduation requirements; they have the option of selecting periods of LATE ARRIVAL or EARLY RELEASE on their registration sheet. The maximum number of LATE ARRIVAL / EARLY RELEASE periods is two each semester.

We do <u>not</u> recommend EARLY RELEASE for students who are planning to attend a four-year college or university! Colleges like to see students taking a full load their senior year and going beyond the graduation requirements to take courses that will better prepare them for academic success in college.

In order to be eligible to participate in <u>athletics</u>, students must take and pass a minimum of 3 classes in the semester preceding their sport. They must take a minimum of 2 classes during the semester of their sport.

Students who receive <u>social security benefits</u> from a disabled or deceased parent must maintain full-time attendance in order to keep their benefits once they turn 18 years old.

In order to maintain an orderly and safe environment at Eastern Wayne High School, seniors who choose LATE ARRIVAL or EARLY RELEASE must adhere to the following guidelines:

- If you opt for LATE ARRIVAL, you must have your own transportation to school; you may not be arrive or be dropped off earlier than 10 minutes for the start of your first class.
- If you opt for EARLY RELEASE, you must leave campus IMMEDIATELY following your last class. You may not remain in a teacher's room, stay for lunch, or hang out in the hallways/parking lot/sidewalks.
- Once you leave EWHS after your last class, you are not allowed on any other WCPS campus without proper approval from that school's principal.
- All athletes and band/choral students may return for practice AFTER school has ended for the day. You may not remain on campus to wait for practice to begin.
- Students who do not follow these guidelines may be charged with TRESPASSING.
