

## Guadalupe Rodriguez Memorial Scholarship

Beginning with the Class of 2000, a graduate of Bath High School planning to attend an accredited college, university, or technical college, in pursuit of a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, or Associate degree, will receive a grant of \$1,000. The funds must be used to pay for tuition, fees, and books in pursuit of that degree. This grant is in memory of Maria Gudalupe Rodriguez, who passed away in August of 1999.

For the last 14 years, "Grandma Lu", as she came to be known by the athletes of the Class of 2000, helped prepare team meals, never missed a televised game or radio broadcast of "her boys", and watched film every week with Coach Sielschott. She didn't distinguish between TV games, be they pro, college, or high school. Consequently she was particularly amazed when her boys were playing on TV. She continually badgered those with her with questions, mainly "which one is Tim, which one is Nate, which one is Wolfe, Bryant, Diep, Ryan, Dante, Sean, Aaron, Scott, Kyle, Griff" and so on.

The Rodriguez family will never forget when all the boys walked together into the funeral home, driving all the way to Rockford, in the midst of two-a-day practices, to be with Tim at that difficult time, and to pay their respects to this kind, gentle, and loving woman to whom they meant so much. Each year our family will honor her memory, and the kindness shown us by the wonderful Bath community at the time of her death, by the granting of this annual scholarship.
