

The Ryan Young Memorial Scholarship Fund, Inc.

Revised May 1999

(See Article 12 of the Rules and regulations Section)

The Ryan Young Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 1990 by Rick and Sharon Young, for the purpose of aiding worthy student from Bath High School to continue their education beyond high school.

The Scholarship Fund was developed in the memory of Ryan "Pup" young, an honor student athlete, who was tragically taken from us in the summer of 1990. Ryan played football, basketball, and participated in weightlifting at Bath High School with a goal of becoming a scholarship athlete at a Division 1 University. "Pup's" chance of fulfilling his goal was taken from him, but with this scholarship, his memory will remain with Ryan's family, friends, classmates, teammates, teachers, and coaches through another young student athlete.

The Ryan Young Memorial Scholarship Fund is a non-profit corporation directed by a Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees has established certain criteria for the determination of recipients of scholarships and rules and regulation concerning payments of scholarships. All applications for scholarship are required to familiarize themselves with these rules and regulations of the corporation.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE RYAN YOUNG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND HAVE ABSOLUTE DESCRETION IN SELECTING RECIPIENTS OF SCHOALRSHIPS AND IN DETERMINING AMOUNTS OF SAID SCHOALRSHIP.
2. APPLICANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP MUST
 - a. Be a resident of Allen County
 - i. Furnish proof of residency upon request.
 - ii. Fit residency requirement laws of the State of Ohio
 - b. Be a Bath High School Senior
3. APPLICANT MUST BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER
 - a. In the event that any scholarship recipient be in violation of a felony and/or drug abuse/ trafficking under the Court of Law, his/her educational scholarship will be terminated and he/she will no longer receive the benefits thereof.
4. APPLICANT MUST BE A GOOD SCHOLAR
 - a. Student must have a 2.5 grade point average

5. APPLICANT MUST BE AN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHELETE WITH LEADERSHIP QUALITIES
 - a. Be prompt to practices, meetings, games, training sessions, etc
 - b. Have good communications with teammates and coaches
 - c. Lead by example on and off the court/field
 - d. Be willing to work extra for self or others

6. APPLICANT MUST BE RECOMMENDED BY
 - a. Teacher
 - b. Coach
 - c. Community Leader

7. APPLICANTS MUST FILED THE APPLICATION FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP COMPLETELY AND BY THE DUE DATE TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP. FAILURE TO FILE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTRUCTION MAY, AT THE SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES, RESULT IN THE APPLICATION NOT BEING CONSIDERED BY THE SAID BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

8. WHEN AN APPLICANT HAS BEEN NAMED AS THE RECIPIENT OF THE SCHOALRSHIP, HE/SHE SHALL BY AUGUST 1 IN THE YEAR OF THE SCHOALRHSIP, PRESENT TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF HIS/ HER ACCEPTANCE AT A COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, TRADE, OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL. FAILUTRE TO DO SO WILL FORFEIT THE SCHOALARSHIP.

9. SCHOLARSHIP MONIES WILL BE PAID DIRECTLY TO THE COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, TRADE OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL OF THE RECIPIENT'S CHOICE AND WILL NOT BE PAID TO THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT UNDER NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES. THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP SHALL BE DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF QUARTERS OR SEMESTERS IN THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT'S ACADEMIC OR TAINING YEAR AND THE PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP SHALL BE MADE TO HT ESCHOALRSHIP RECIPIENT'S SCHOOL ACCORDINGLY EACH QUARTER OR SEMESTER.

10. THE RECIPIENT MUST MAINTAIN A 2.0 GPA (ON A 4.0 SCALE) OR THE EQUIVALENT THEREOF.

11. IN THE EVENT THAT ANY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT BECOMES A MEMBER OF OR ASSOCIATES WITH, THE COMMUNIT PARTY OR ANY GROUP ADVOCATING THE VIOLENT OVERTHROW OF OUR EXISTING FORM OF GOVERNMENT, HIS/HER SCHLARSHIP WILL BE TERMINATED AND HE/SHE MAY NOT LONGER RECEIVE THE BENEFITS THEREOF.

12. APPLICATIONS FOR THE RYAN YOUNG MEMORAIL SCHOALRSHIP WILL BE RETURNED TO THE BATH HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE OFFICE BY MAY 1.
