

Daily Health Screening

In order to help keep everyone healthy and the schools open it will be important that parents assess their children's health daily before coming to school each day. It will be important that you keep your child home if they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. One case of the virus could lead to a quarantine of a class, grade, school or the district depending on the contact a child has with others on the bus and/or within a building.

Please use the following flow chart to assess your child(ren) daily to determine whether they are healthy and able to attend school on a daily basis.

Exposure: Within the last 14 days, have you been in contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19 (nasal swab)?

Were you within 6 feet of that person for 15 minutes or longer?

QUARANTINE AT HOME
Return to school after:
-14 days from last contact unless symptoms develop
-If symptoms develop, contact a healthcare provider

SYMPTOMS: Within the last 24 hours, have you had any of the following sign and symptoms of illness?

HIGH RISK SYMPTOMS

- + New Cough
- + Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- + Change or loss of taste/smell

LOW RISK SYMPTOMS

- Fever (>100.4F)/Chills
- Congestion/runny nose
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Sore throat
- Headache
- Muscle weakness/body aches/fatigue

Any one **HIGH RISK** symptom **AND/OR** two or more **LOW RISK** symptoms

Only one **LOW RISK** symptom

Seek evaluation by a healthcare provider & based on results:

Positive COVID-19 laboratory result/medically diagnosed positive COVID-19 case

- Isolate at home
- Return to school after
 - 24 hours without fever, without the use of fever reducing medications
 - **AND** 10 days since first symptom
 - **AND** symptoms improving

- Isolate at home
- Return to school after
 - 24 hours without fever, without the use of fever reducing medications
 - **AND** 10 days since first symptom
 - **AND** symptoms improving

Alternate diagnosis OR negative COVID-19 nasal swab test

Recommend isolation at home

- Return to school after:
 - 24 hours without fever, without the use of fever reducing medications
 - **AND** symptoms improving
