



2026 Liberty Benton Music Boosters Scholarship Application

The Liberty Benton Music Boosters established a scholarship in order to recognize students in the music program at Liberty Benton High School. The Scholarship will be awarded annually depending upon booster funding for \$500. The award is a single payment and is non-renewable. It will be paid directly to the institution upon the receipt of the student's first grading period by the LBHS guidance office.

Criteria for selection of recipients of the Liberty Benton Music Boosters Scholarship:

1. Scholarship may be awarded annually depending upon booster funding. This decision will be made by the music boosters. Per the Directors' discretion up to two awards of \$500 each may be awarded.
2. The scholarship will be awarded to a student(s) who is a Liberty Benton High School senior involved in music programs at LBHS.
3. Students must be attending a 2 or 4-year institution full time and either majoring in music or participating in a music program at their respective university.
4. Grade point average may be taken into consideration.
5. The recipient of this scholarship shall be selected by the Band and Choir Directors.

Applications must be submitted to the high school guidance counselor no later than **April 24, 2026**.
