Eligibility:

- 1. Any Bath High School alumni or contributing community member. In order for alumni to be nominated, they must have graduated at least twenty years prior to their nomination.
- 2. Nominees must have received local, state or national recognition for accomplishments in the category for which they are nominated.
- 3. The candidate must be of good character and in good standing with the community.

Required Documents: This nomination form and two letters from individuals supporting your nomination must be submitted by March 31st to be considered for this year's Hall of Fame ceremony. Applications received after March 31st will be considered for the next induction ceremony. Any nominations not selected will automatically be used for the next cycle of nominations.
