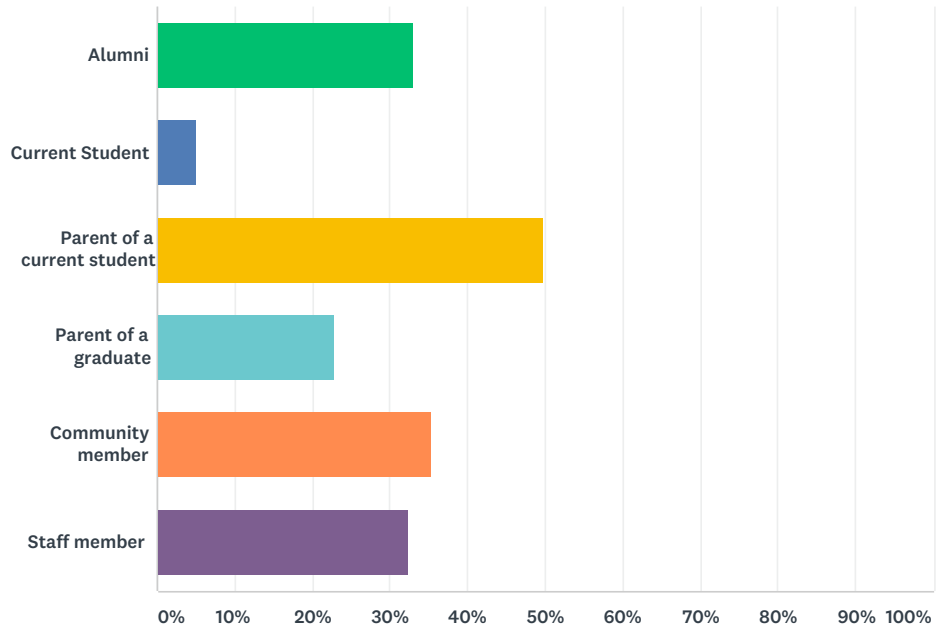

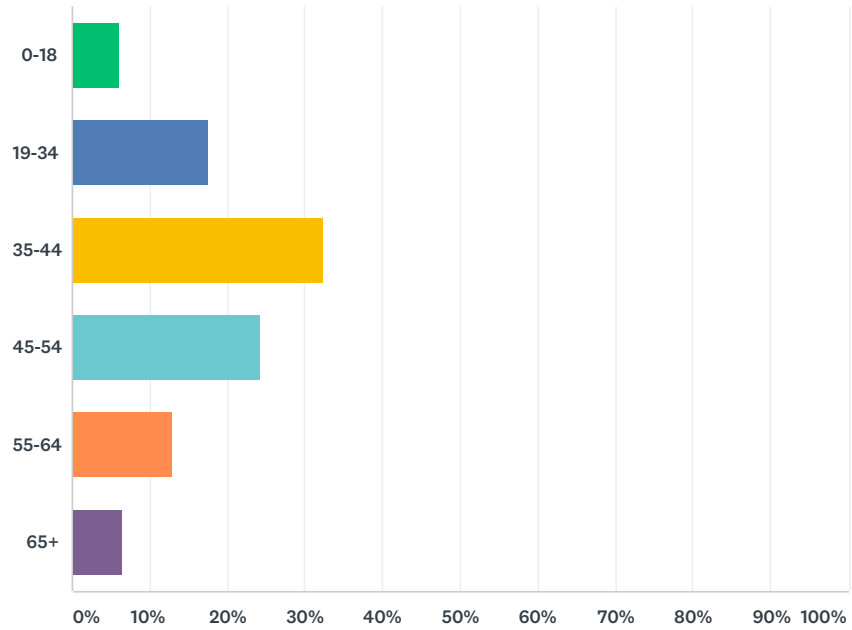

Q3 What age group do you belong?

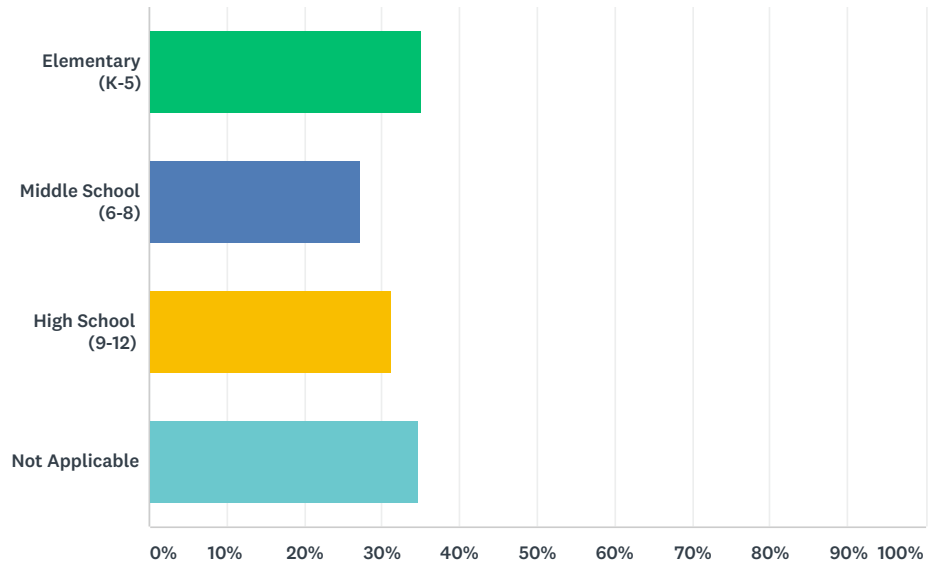

Q4 If you have children/grandchildren in the district, what is the grade level for each student? Check all that apply.

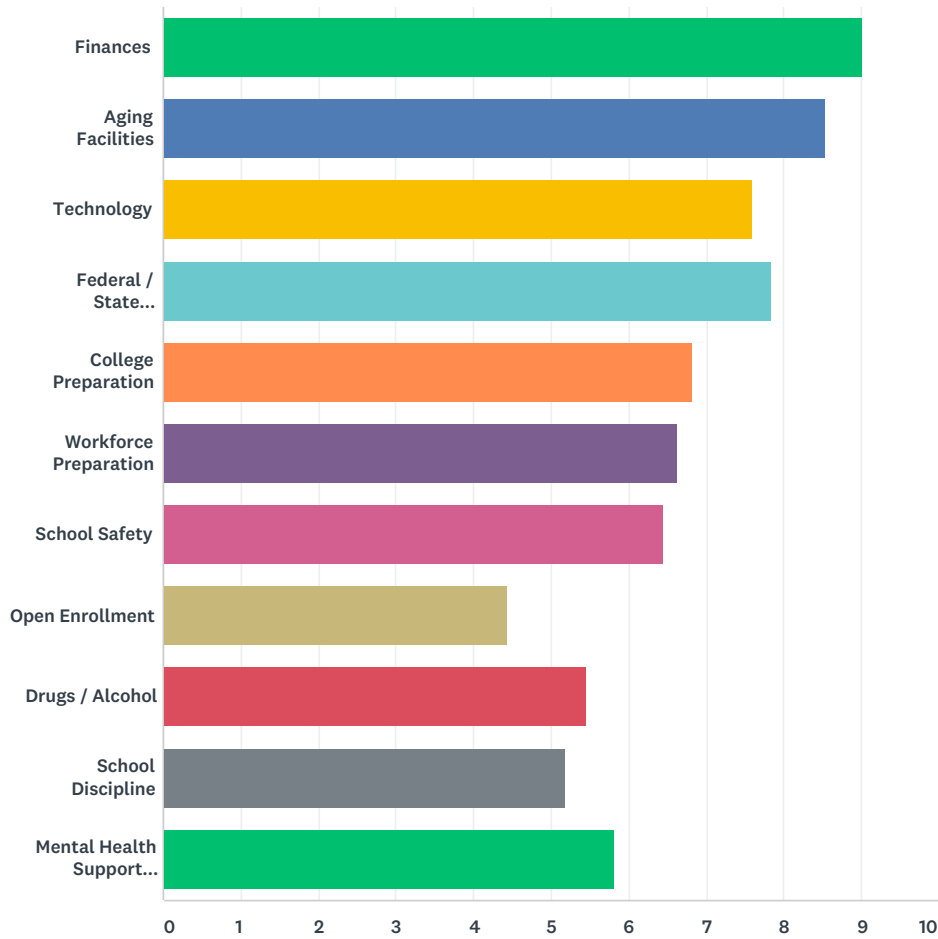

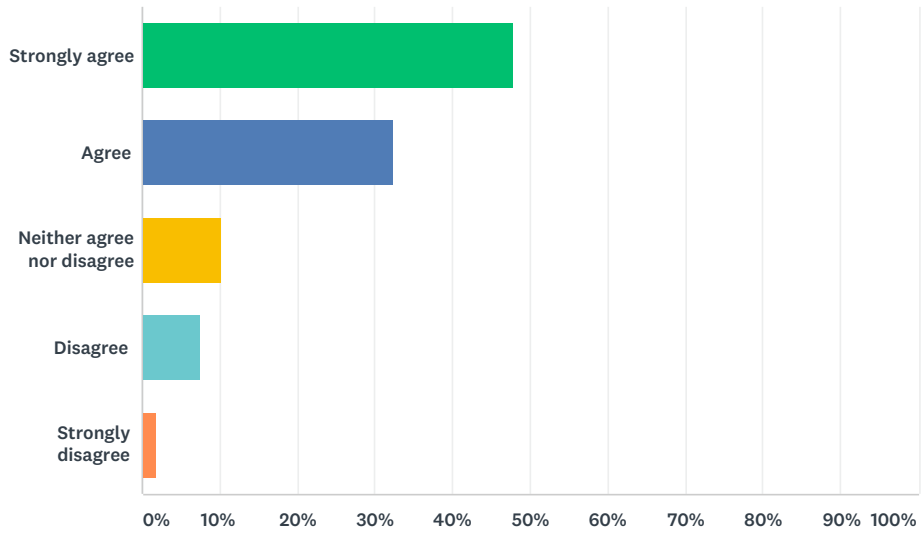

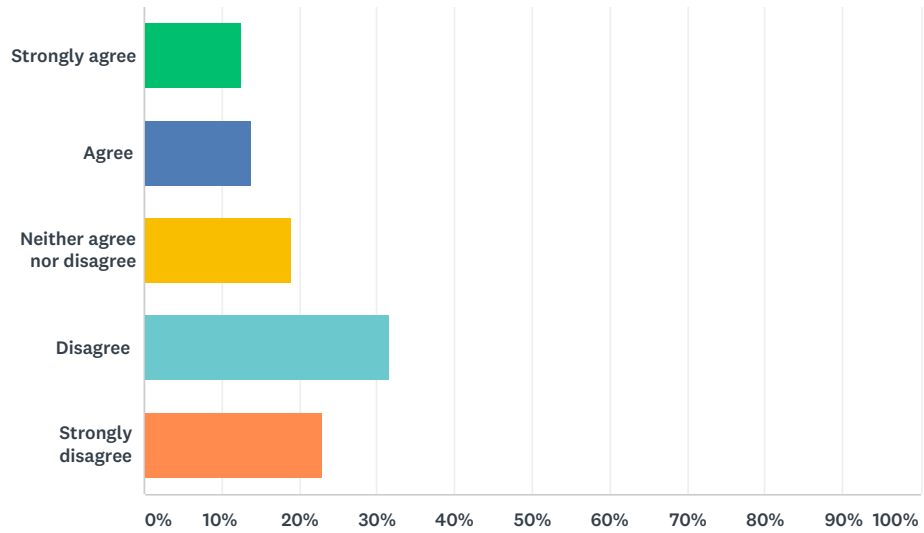

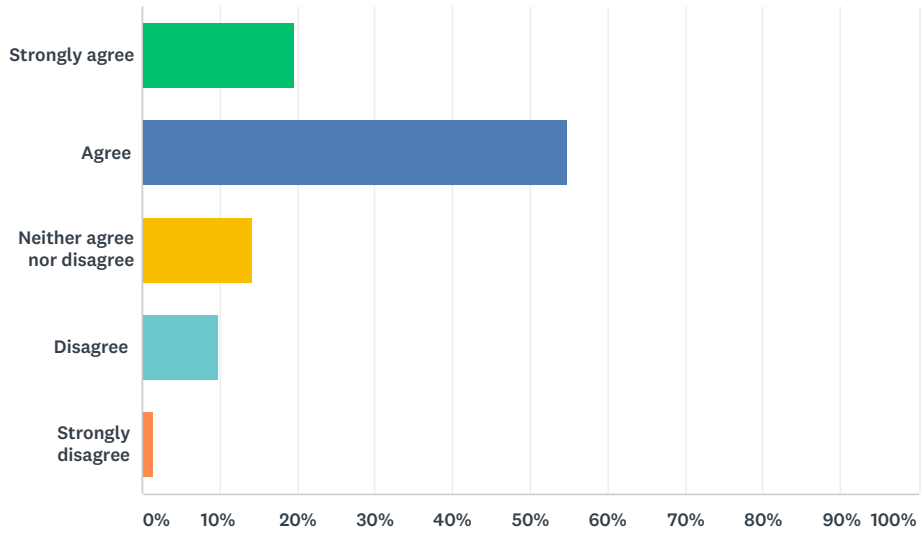

Q14 I believe the students in each building are safe.

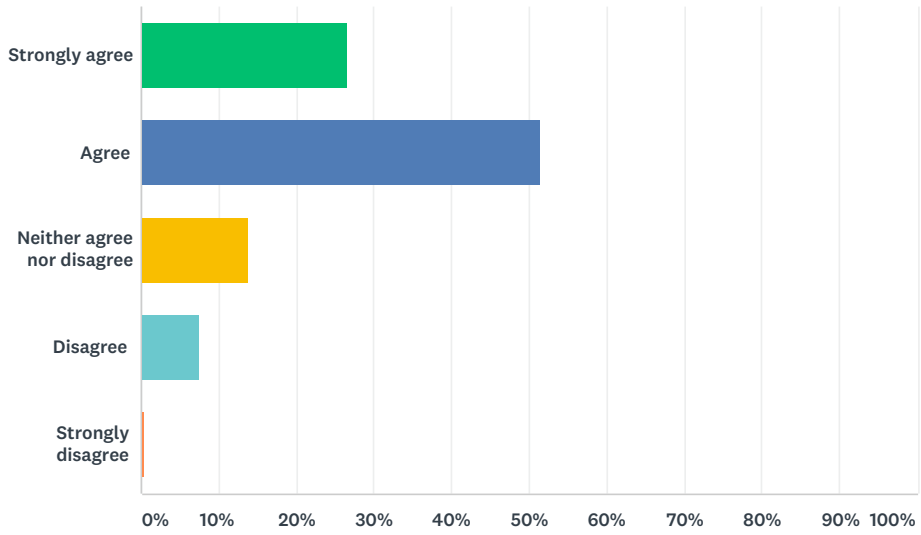

Q15 I believe our district places a priority on school safety.

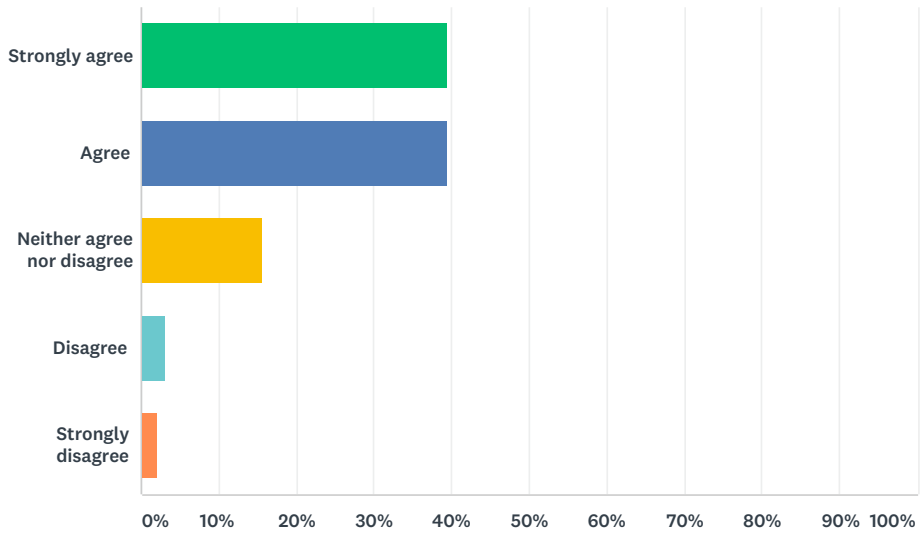

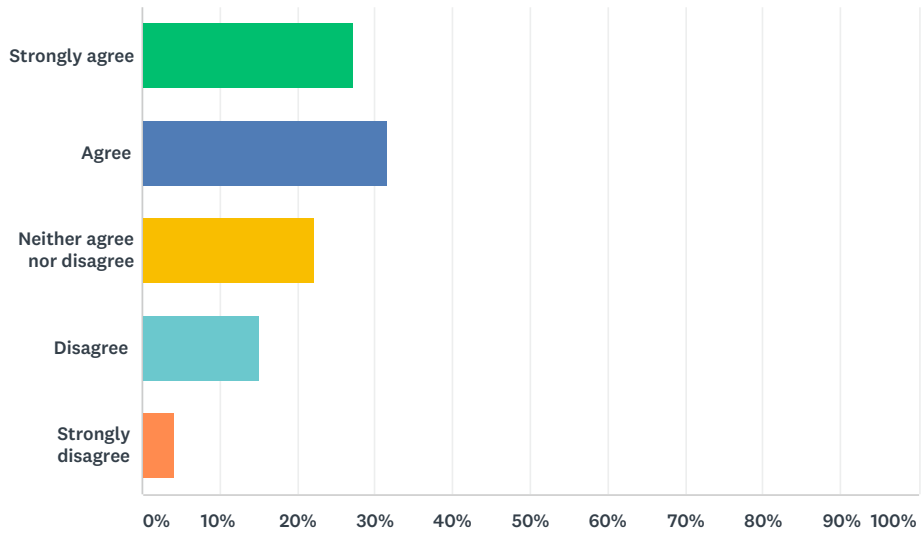

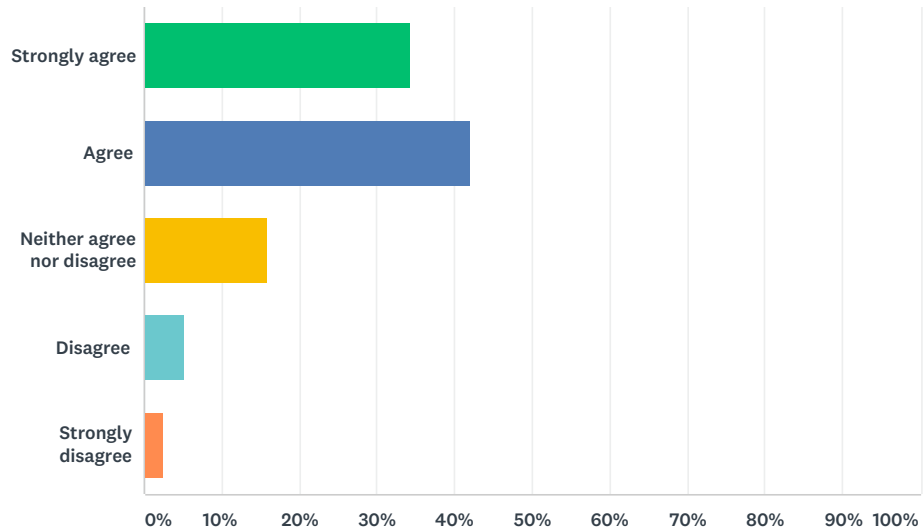

Q18 I would support the addition of a social worker / mental health professional on campus every day.

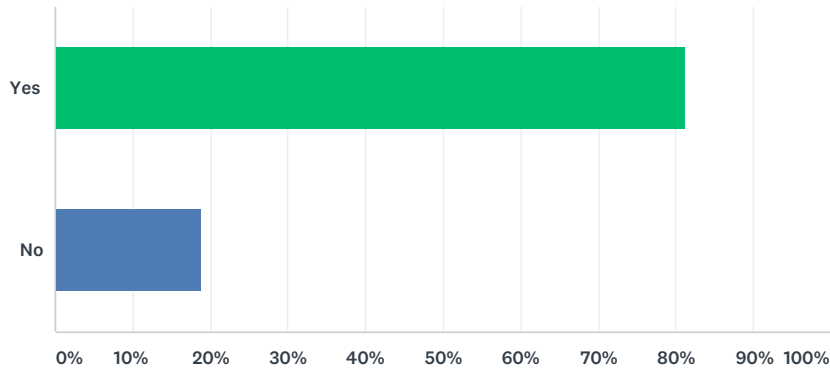

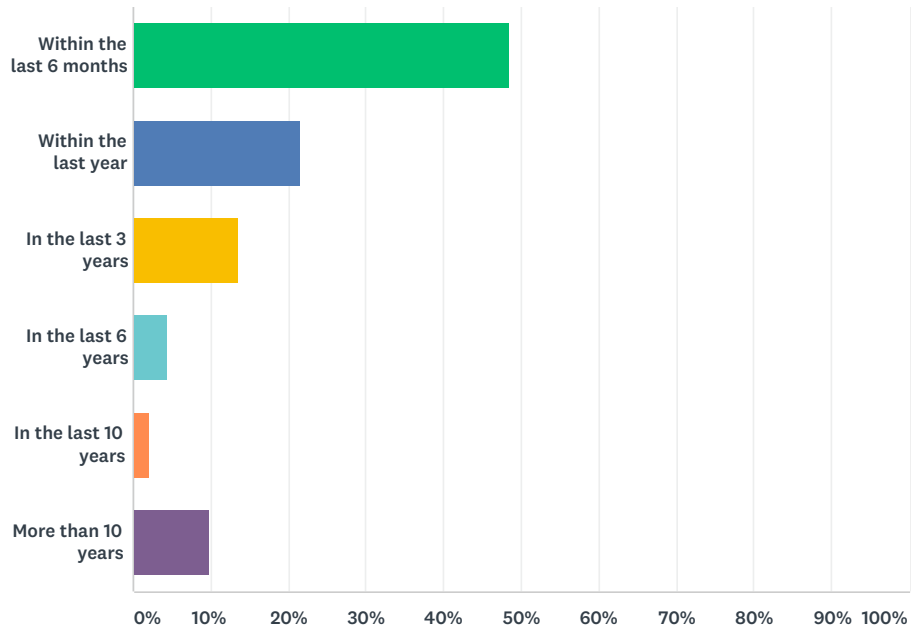

Q20 When was the last time you were in the Middle School building, besides visiting the gym?

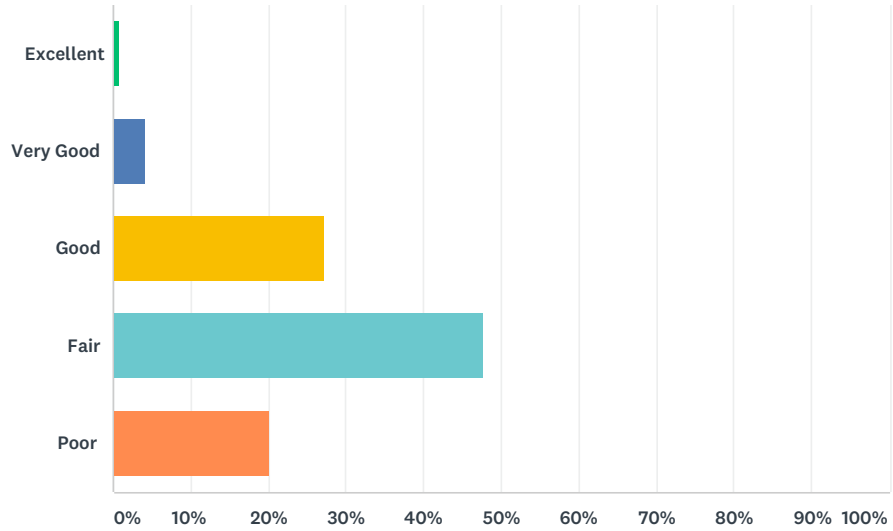

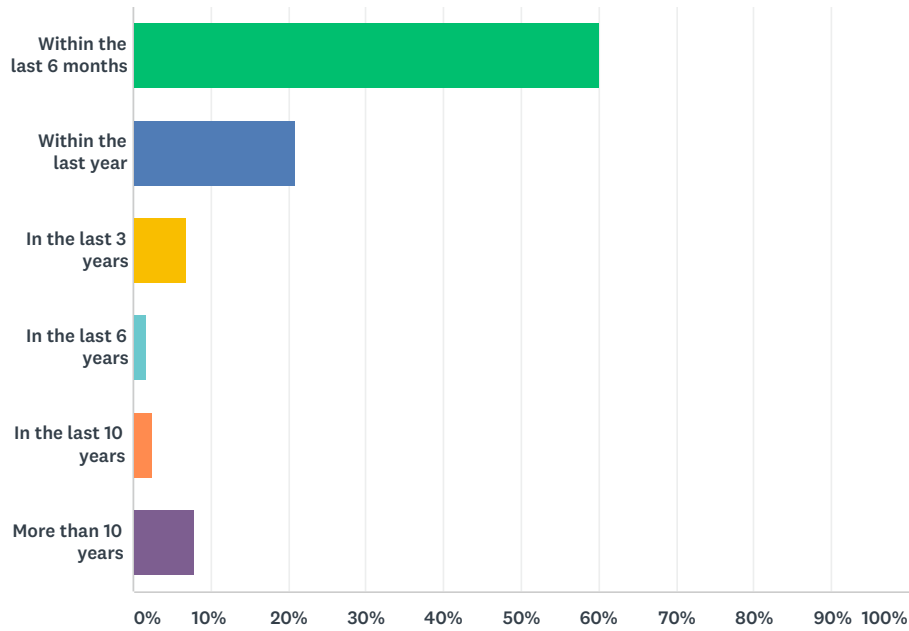

Q22 When was the last time you were in the High School building, besides visiting the gym or auditorium?

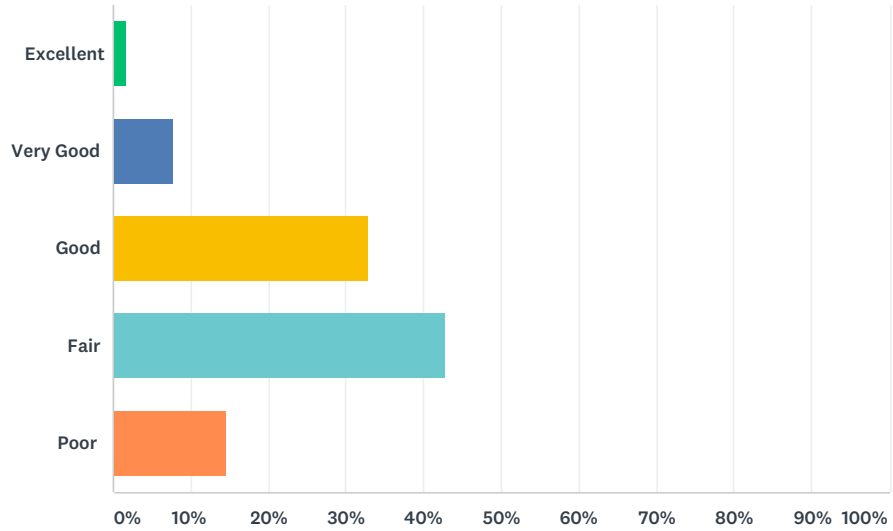

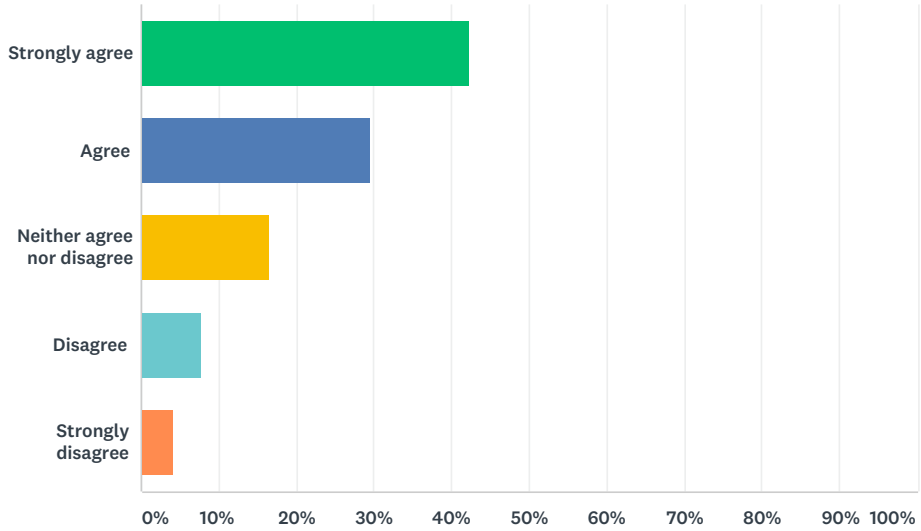

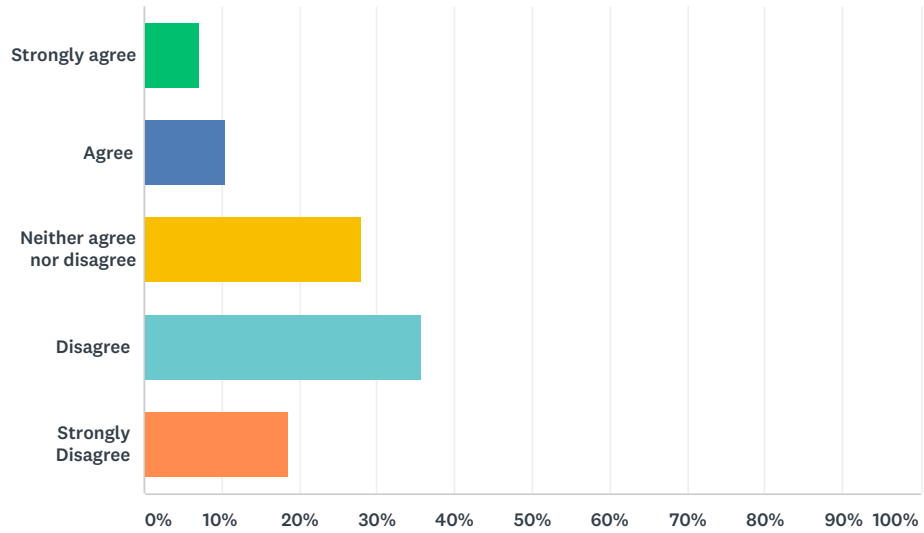

Q25 Instead of a new 6-12 building, we should look to go from 2 buildings to one, adding classrooms to the high school and tearing down the middle school.

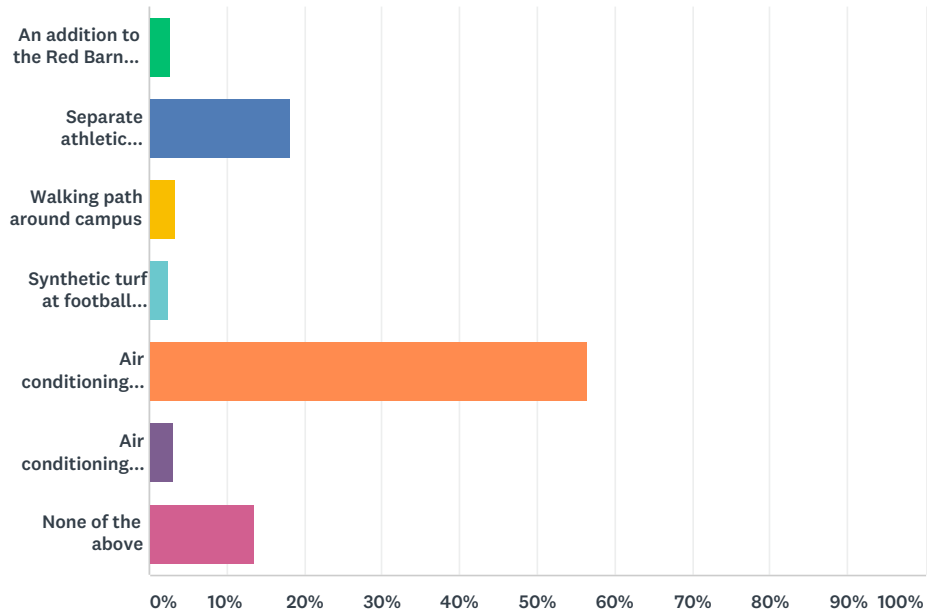

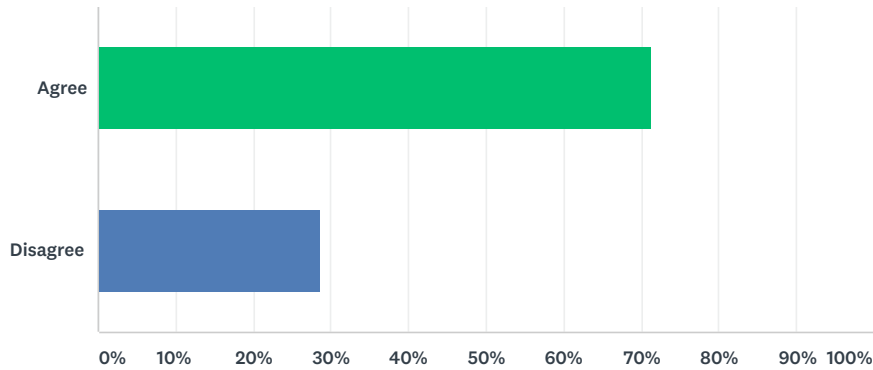

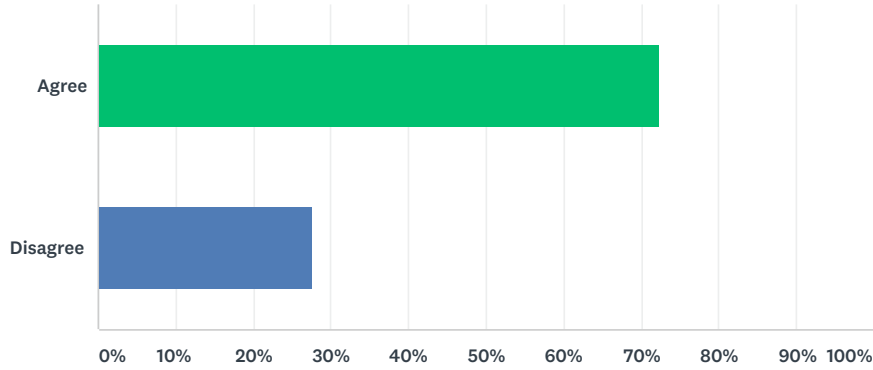

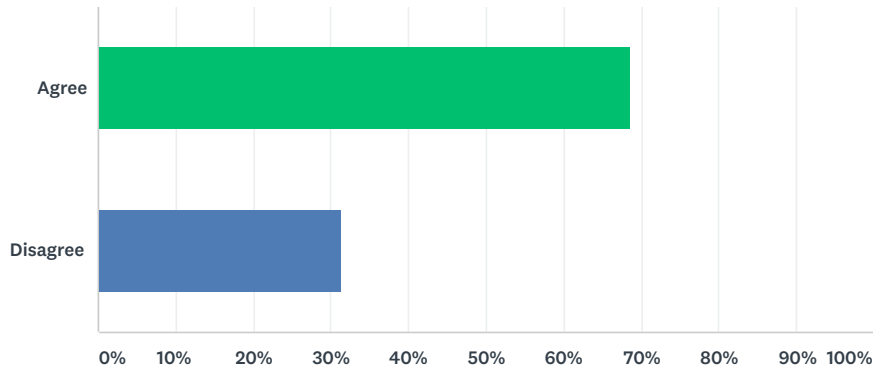
