## Dear Parents:

First and foremost, let me thank you from the bottom of my heart for your partnership during this time of online learning. This has not been an easy time for anyone, yet parents and staff have risen to the challenge of providing the best education possible for our children given the circumstances. I am extremely proud to be your child's principal and wish the end of the school year could have ended differently. That being said, times are different and require us to think and respond accordingly. Below you will find several important end of year items. Please read and follow them carefully to ensure the safety and health of our community.

## • The last day for online learning is going to be Friday, May 15.

If your child has missing assignments, they will have until May 22 to get those completed and turned into their teacher.

# • Parent pickup of student items and drop off of books, computers, etc.

In order to limit the number of people in the elementary building at one time, we have assigned specific times and procedures for each family to come pickup their child's items and drop off the school's supplies. Only one adult will be permitted to enter the building per student. No students will be permitted to enter the building. Parents will need to come during their designated date and time below. We are asking you to park in the bus lot and enter/exit the door with the child's grade noted on the attached map. Please go to your child's classroom. All of your child's items to be taken home will be on your child's desk with their name on it. Please take the items that are on your child's desk and return all school items, ie. textbooks, library books, computers, chargers, etc., on to your child's desk. If at all possible, we would ask you please wear a mask and gloves during this time.

## • OneView Parent Portal for 2020-2021school year.

If you have any changes over the summer with phone numbers, your child's health, your address, etc., please log on to the OneView Parent Portal you created last May and make the necessary changes. This will allow us to stay up to date on all information on all of our students. The OneView Parent Portal can be found by going to the Bath website: <a href="www.bathwildcats.org">www.bathwildcats.org</a> and clicking on the registration tab on the left. Once you are there, you will click on the submit and view online forms and then you will click on the student demographics and EMA. Here is where you will need to update any changes that have occurred over the summer.

## • KG screening for the 2020-2021school year:

Our KG screening dates have been <u>moved from May to August</u>. All registered KG students will be assigned a KG screening date and time. Letters with exact times, dates and information regarding screenings will be mailed to parents in June.

- To be eligible, <u>a child must be 5 years old</u> <u>on or before August 1, 2020</u>. If you have a child who meets this qualification:
  - Visit <u>www.bathwildcats.org</u> and click on the registration link on the upper left hand side of the screen.
  - Provide the elementary office with the child's birth certificate (which includes mother's maiden name), social security card, immunization information, custody papers (if applicable including all pages of the document and the judge or magistrate's signature), and three documents providing proof of residence in the Bath Local School District. All of these items must be submitted to the elementary before kindergarten screening takes place. The preferred methods of getting these documents to our office are:

    - Take a picture of the documents and email them to kdgscr@bathwildcats.org
    - If you need to come in for us to make copies, please come between the hours of 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM Monday Friday starting the week of May 11.
