Eligibility:

In order to participate in commencement exercises students are required to:

- EOC – State Testing Requirements
- Attain 21 credits distributed according to the graduation requirements adopted by the Trotwood-Madison Board of Education.
- Pay all outstanding fees and fines, return or pay for lost books and/or equipment, and clear all other obligations, including those from the Miami Valley Career Technology Center and Jostens.
- Participation in the graduation practice to be held the morning of Tuesday, May 19th.

Ceremony:

Commencement exercises will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m. Doors will open for parents and guests at 6:00 p.m. Security personnel will lock the doors at 7:00 p.m. and will not admit anyone during the processional. Once the processional is complete, Security Personnel will admit late arrivals, providing seats are available. You have no guarantee of entry if you arrive after 7:00 p.m. **NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE STAGE. EVERYONE MUST STAY BEHIND THE AREA ROPED OFF.**

Required Practice:

Graduating seniors must attend practice on Tuesday, May 19th at 10:00 a.m. at the University of Dayton to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Dress Code:

Ladies:

- White dresses, white skirts and white tops – no prints, please – make sure the dress does not hang below robe.
- White dress shoes.
- No purses during ceremony.

Gentlemen:

- Black dress pants.
- White dress shirts with tie.
- Black dress shoes and black socks.

Both Ladies and Gentlemen:

- No athletic shoes or Timberlands.
- No sunglasses.
- Jewelry in moderation.
- No cell phones or any other electronic devices during the ceremony.
- No cameras or camcorders during the ceremony.
- Please do not dance or celebrate on the stage when we call your name – show dignity and respect.
- No gum or candy.

Reminder to Students:

Participation in senior activities, including commencement, is a privilege. Any misbehavior on the part of any senior during school or any school-related activity, during graduation practice, or during the graduation ceremony may result in the loss of the privilege to participate in any senior activity, including commencement. Also, we reserve the right to withhold your diploma.

Any student who does not participate in the commencement exercises, but has met all graduation requirements may pick up his/her cap & gown and/or diploma in the high school office after May 19, 2020.

Cap/Gowns can't be returned once they have been picked up.
