# **COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS OPPORTUNITIES & PROGRAM**

## **REQUIREMENTS**

### 1. **DESCRIPTION**

- Opportunity for college-ready students, grades 7-12, who qualify for college admission to take college classes and receive college and high school credit.

### 2. **COST**

- There is no cost (tuition, books, fees, etc.) to students for participating in CC+ at an Ohio Public University. (If you choose to attend a private institution, you may have to pay a fee.)
- Students will only pay for classes that they fail or classes they do not earn credit for completing.

### 3. **COUNSELING**

- Students must attend an informational meeting about CC+ with the high school counselor. Partnered colleges may be in attendance.
- If you choose to do CC+, you must attend a counseling session with an advisor at the college.

### 4. **OPTIONS**

- Students may earn high school credits through any combination of college classes and classes taken at the high school.
- Students may attend multiple colleges in one school year.
- Students may follow the listed pathways with the partnered institution; however, this is not required.
- Students may take college classes at the university, on line, or at the high school (when available).

### 5. **DEADLINES**

- If you choose to participate in CC+, you must sign a letter of intent and turn it in to Mrs. Metz by April 1.
- Students must apply to the college by the specified admission deadline as required by the college you are attending.

### 6. **REQUIREMENTS**

- These are determined by the college

## CC+ and Credits

Students (by law) are permitted to earn a maximum of 30 credit hours between the high school and college per academic year and not more than 120 college credit hours in high school.

- Each student must not exceed full-time status. Full-time status is determined as follows:
  - 1.) Determine student's number of high school **ONLY** units,
  - 2.) Multiply that number by 3, and
  - 3.) Subtract the result from the number 30
  - 4.) That number is the total number of college credits that CCP student may earn that academic year.

### EXAMPLE:

If a student is taking 4 credit hours at the high school, that converts to 12 semester hours, which means the student is eligible to take up to a total of 18 semester hours at the college in that year.

$$30 - (4 \times 3) = 18$$

- Convert college credit as follows:  
Each CCP course: If 3 or more college credits, convert to 1 Carnegie unit. If less than 3 college credits, convert proportionally.

## **POSSIBLE CC+ ISSUES**

- **Student cannot schedule the classes at their home school to work out with the classes they want at the college.**  
**\*\*\* BIGGEST ISSUE \*\*\***
- Students are not prepared for the rigors and independence of college
- Student receives grade lower than expected in CC+. \*Keep in mind that your CC+ grade DOES count in your overall high school GPA.
- The class the student wants to take at the college is full.
- Student does not take the courses needed to meet graduation requirements.
- Students have difficulty scheduling college classes and participating in athletics and other extracurricular activities
- Student misses deadlines. It is important to stay connected with the high school by checking the daily announcements and web site to know what is happening. May miss out on important information and opportunities.

# WHAT SHOULD I DO NOW?

## **CC+ Timeline & Responsibilities of the student:**

- 1) Attend an information/counseling session in January.
- 2) Notify your counselor **by APRIL 1** if you plan to participate in College Credit Plus. The form called “**Intent to Participate**” should be signed and turned in by **April 1**, which constitutes notice. **Sign and turn in the Statement of Responsibility to Mrs.Metz.**
- 3) Schedule an appointment with your counselor to discuss graduation requirements and the classes you wish to take at the high school.
- 4) Apply to the college. \*There is no application fee for CC+.\*
- 5) Once accepted, contact the college to take your placement tests, if applicable, and/or meet with the CC+ advisor to schedule classes.
- 6) **\*\*\*\*Remember, your CC+ class schedule must work around your schedule at WHS. We cannot guarantee that your CC+ classes will fit in with your classes WHS\*\*\*\***
- 7) Plan for transportation to/from your college classes.
- 8) You must pay for any classes that you fail or drop after the stated deadline at the college.
- 9) **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR WHAT YOU MISS AT WHS WHEN YOU ARE NOT HERE.**
