

Remote--Remote learning will occur if the health department issues a “hard close” of school buildings. This means no students will be permitted in the building. Learning will be done from home. The health department will determine if teachers will be permitted in the building.

<p>Teacher Expectations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Post all standards, assignments, and resources to Google Website on Mondays by 3:00 PM ○ Make one Google Meet available per prep. ○ Make yourself available through office hours by appointment as needed. ○ Teachers will update their gradebooks weekly. Gradebooks should never be more than a week behind. ○ Teachers should document any communication with parents. Teachers should forward the names of any parents they have been unable to reach or any students that do not complete work for two consecutive weeks to administration. ○ Student/parent emails should be responded to within 24 hours.
<p>Student Expectations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ It is the responsibility of the student to check their teachers’ Google Classroom page daily for posted assignments. ○ Completion of assignments may be tied to students' attendance. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ All students will be held to Ohio’s student attendance laws. ■ Credits and grade level promotion will be based on attendance and completed work. ○ Assignments should be completed within a week of being assigned. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Assignments will be considered “missing” until turned in. ■ After one week past the due date, the assignment will be given a zero unless there has been a documented illness or direct communication with the teacher. ○ It is the responsibility of the students (or parents of students in primary grades) to contact the teacher for clarification of any assignments. Communication from students should be made via Gmail or during assigned Google Meet Sessions. ○ During online classes, students should adhere to the discipline guidelines in the student handbook.
<p>Parent Expectations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Parents are expected to provide Internet access for their children to complete their academics. If unable to provide Internet access, parents should contact building administrators. ○ Parents are expected to provide an appropriate space for students to complete their school work and attend online meetings. ○ It is the responsibility of the students (or parents of students in primary grades) to contact the teacher for clarification of any assignments. Communication from students should be made via Gmail or during assigned Google Meet Sessions. Parents should email a teacher’s school email address to communicate with teachers. ○ Monitor Progress Book weekly. If you do not have access to Progress Book, please contact building secretaries or administrators. ○ Behavior during online meetings should follow the students handbook guidelines. ○ Please allow teachers 24 hours to answer emails. Email your child’s teacher for clarification of any questions or issues before emailing administration.

Hybrid Model--This will occur if it is determined the school cannot operate at full capacity. This model combines online learning and a traditional school setting.

- Schedule
 - Monday is a remote day unless there is a scheduled holiday or non-student day with the following exceptions:
 - IEP support as scheduled by that student’s intervention specialist.
 - Students that need social or emotional support will receive services.
 - Students that did not meet academic/attendance expectations during the previous or current quarter.
 - Students that require gifted services.
 - Group A - Tuesday and Thursday at school (Last name begins with an A-K)
 - Group B - Wednesday and Friday at school (Last name begins with an L-Z) * **Students in the same household with a different last name, the parent should contact their child’s building to have them in the same group - the building Principal will decide which group your children will be in based on numbers.**

Students are permitted to bring their own bottles of water. ○ Use of lockers will not be permitted. Students will take all coats and bags to class.

REO--Remote Educational Opportunity

This is an educational option for families that choose not to send their students to school whether school is fully open or using the hybrid model.

- Curriculum will be provided through Margareta by a third party.
- Students will need to choose this option through Margareta on a semester basis.
- Students that choose this option are still considered Margareta students and all communication will be done through administration.

For all learning styles:

All teachers will have Google Classroom and use the Google Suite regardless of learning model.

Grading-

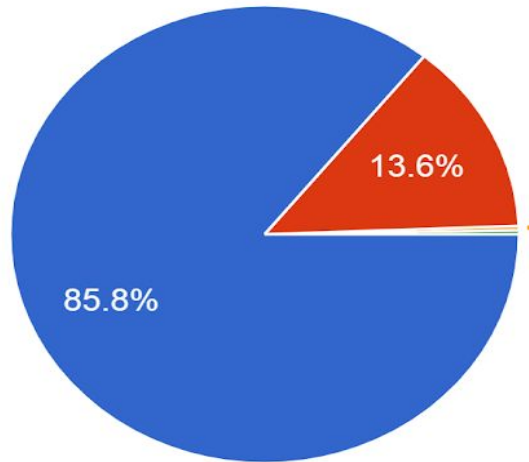
- Grading policies for each class will be communicated to students on the first day of school.
 - Weighted Grades
 - No weight (points)
 - 50% Minimum for standards with the opportunity for correction up to 75%.
 - Assignments not turned in will be considered “missing.”
- Teachers will update their gradebooks weekly. Gradebooks should never be more than a week behind.
- Grades for remote learning will mirror “in class” grading policies. Expectations for students in fall will be much different than expectations in the spring.
- Assignments should be completed within a week of being assigned. Assignments will be considered “missing” until turned in. After one week past the due date, the assignment will be given a zero unless there has been a documented illness AND direct communication with the teacher.

Attendance

- Completion of assignments may be tied to students' attendance. All students will be held to Ohio's student attendance laws. Credits and grade level promotion will be based on attendance and completed work.

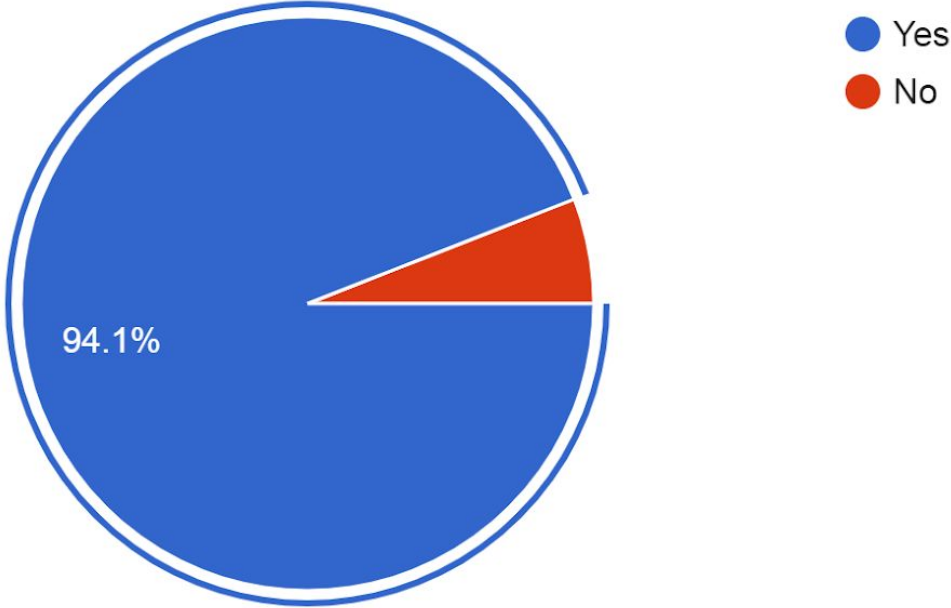

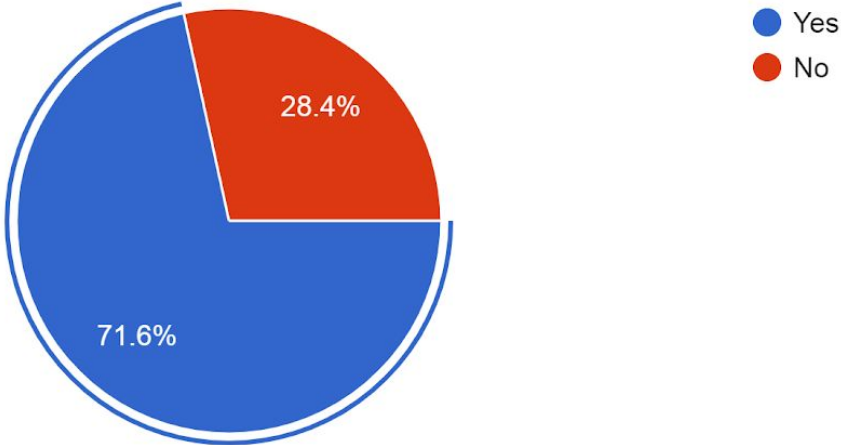

Will your child/children be using busing for the 2020-2021 school year?

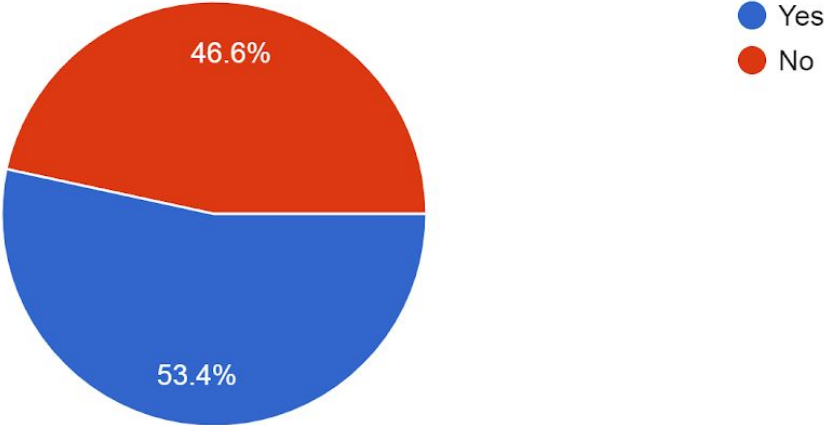
