## **Margaretta Local Schools COVID Reporting Practice**

If a Margaretta Local School District student or staff member tests positive or has a clinical diagnosis for COVID-19, the student's parent or guardian – or faculty/staff member – should report their condition to the school district within 24 hours, [as ordered by Ohio Gov. Mike DeWine](#).

According to the announcement, when Margaretta Schools receives a report of a COVID-19 case, whether it's a student or staff/faculty member, the information will be shared with the Erie County Health Department within 24 hours.

Margaretta Schools, per the order, also must inform the district's families that a positive case has been reported and the building(s) where he or she attends school or works. That report to families must be made within 24 hours.

No personal health information will be shared publicly in compliance with privacy laws.

Parents/guardians or staff/faculty members who need to report a positive COVID case should call Mr. Steve Keller, Margaretta Schools COVID Coordinator, at 419-684-5351.

If a Margaretta student attends classes at Firelands-BGSU or EHOVE, or takes classes via the Online-Only Curriculum, they still should report positive test results to Margaretta Schools.

As required by Gov. DeWine's order, Margaretta Local Schools will provide regular updates via our website at [www.margarettaschooldistrict.com](http://www.margarettaschooldistrict.com) and via district-wide emails.

The updates will provide information about new cases detailed by students and staff and the buildings they attend or which they work. The emails will not provide contact tracing information; that information will be provided to families by the Erie County Health Department.

The information will NOT be shared on social media.
