



## Beginning Research

It is often difficult to select a research subject. Using the Gale Opposing Viewpoints database should help.

This is what you do:

### At Red Land High School -

Log-on to the computer, use Google Chrome

Open a new window (+ sign at the top, like a tab)

Type go\ (This will show you the High School Portal, other helpful links too)

Select Red Land Library on the left side under Sites

This menu will look exactly like what you see on the library computers

### At Home –

Go to the RLHS, pick Red Land Library (on the left)

Home Access (left side) Use passwords

Your teacher may have put these in their Schoology class link

Print copies available in the library

### \*\*\*Click on Gale Databases

Select Opposing Viewpoints (on the right)

Click on Browse Issues (in black bar under Opposing Viewpoints in Context)

This is a large subject list of possible topics

Select a topic that might be of interest

Each subject starts with background information (read more, then back)

Scroll down to see Featured Viewpoints and Viewpoints

If more than 3 under the heading, click on the heading to see all

This will help you find a subject and will also help to narrow it to a more specific area of that topic.

If at any time, you want to get back to the subjects, click on Browse Issues
