Transportation: A fleet of 14 buses, 9 routes, driven by 11 qualified drivers is used to transport 808 public school students, 5 non-public students, 24 vocational students and 42 handicapped students to various schools in our district. During 2023-2024, our buses traveled 448 miles per day on regular runs or 89,705 miles including activities, using approximately 180,000 gallons of gasoline!

During the 2023 - 2023 school year, SCS cafeterias served 317,039 breakfasts and 420,678 lunches for a total of 737,717 meals on 179 days. This averaged 4,121 meals per day. A committed staff worked industriously to produce quality and nutritious food for the students and staff. SCS weekly menus are published on-line at www.hsconnect.com.

- INSTRUCTIONAL & RELATED SERVICES** Includes salaries for professional teaching staff, librarians, school nurses, school psychologists, guidance counselors and attendance officers along with textbooks, teaching supplies, audio-visual equipment, and all necessary accouterments.
- OPERATION TRANSPORTATION & MAINTENANCE** Custodial salaries, heating and utility costs, supplies for building operations, repairs to buildings, maintenance costs, plant equipment, and pupil transportation.
- NON PROGRAMMED** State audit and auditor costs. At various times, it is necessary to transfer funds out of the general fund, usually to supplement federal programs and other accounts as needed. In most cases, funds are replaced when reimbursements are recovered.
