Chipotle Fundraiser (Sarah)


 Earned \$177.41 on April 1st between 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM at the Greece location (thanks Kate Jackson for coordinating)

 - Budget next year to sponsor at least five students, but the feedback is if we do it for one student, we would want to do for all. We don't want anyone to go without.
