

	All parents are asked to speak with graduating seniors about appropriate
	behavior and support the staff and administration in their mission to
	provide a dignified Commencement Ceremony.

- Graduating seniors who engage in inappropriate behavior will be removed from the ceremony. This step is not one we wish to take. We will, however, do so to ensure that <u>ALL</u> graduates receive appropriate recognition and that the ceremony remains formal.
- Please assist us with this effort to provide seniors with the best possible graduation ceremony honoring their accomplishments.
- **Attire Expectations**
 - Business Casual.
 - No tennis shoes, heels are NOT recommended.
- Cords: Graduates must return any loaned cords when exiting the stadium
- Diplomas: Diploma pick up will be available in the arena hallway, as you exit the arena. If you do not pick up your diploma immediately following the end of the ceremony, it will be available in the high school office during normal school hours.
