To: Parents/Guardians of Antwerp Local School Students

Re: Assigned Computer Device

With the start of this school year, every student in grades K – 12 have been assigned a computer device for use during the school day and also for use at home. Currently, students in grades 6 - 12 and students utilizing the NOVA program are permitted to take their computer device home. Students in grades K – 5 will be permitted to take their computer device home during times when our Remote Learning Plan is necessary.

For the past few school years, high school students were charged a \$40 “Assigned Computer Device” cost to cover the cost associated with “wear and tear”, batteries, and other issues arising for the extra use of the computer devices. In consideration of the economic situation many families are experiencing, the “Assigned Computer Device” cost has been lowered to \$10 per student for this school year.

Students in grade K – 8 will bring home to you, either today or tomorrow, an “Assigned Computer Device” form. The form provides details regarding the \$10 payment. Parents with children in grades 9 – 12 may have already been billed the original \$40 cost. The high school office will or may have already been in contact with you to see how you would like the extra \$30 cost distributed.

Please note that the \$10 Technology Fee for grades 6 – 12 included in your child’s Fee Schedule is a separate cost for licenses and subscription costs associated with curriculum courses.
