### **LUNCH PROGRAM**

Parents must complete a Free/Reduced priced Breakfast/Lunch Application form in order for school officials to verify your household income status for qualification of either a free or reduced price for breakfast and/or lunch during the 2023-2024 school year. Applications will be placed in elementary student packets and may be picked up at Open House August 15 or they will be sent home with elementary students their first day of school. MS/HS students will have an application attached to their class schedules.

Note that students who qualify for free breakfast/lunch may also qualify for waivers of workbook fees. Letters are being sent to families who are pre-qualified for the program. It is NOT necessary for Pre-Qualified families to complete the Free/Reduced Application. If you did not receive a letter and want your child to participate, please fill out and return the application form the first week of school.

Lunch prices for students this year will remain the same at \$2.80 for K-5, \$2.90 for 6-12, and \$1.50 for breakfast (all grades). Adult lunch is \$4.00. Extra milk is 50 cents.
