



Wright State University CCP Steps and Deadlines

All students intending to earn college credit and are enrolled in a college credit plus class offered at Wright State University or on the Bellbrook High School campus **must complete all steps** outlined below in order to receive CCP credit. By applying, you confirm that you are enrolling in a college credit plus class for college credit. You acknowledge that you understand that this course, and the grade earned, will appear on both your high school transcript and college permanent records. If you fail the course, you will be held responsible for paying the cost of the class. You will be responsible for requesting an official transcript from the CCP college to be sent to your future college.

- Step 1:** Attend CCP Parent Information Night on Feb 5th. If you were unable to attend on Feb 5th, you must watch the video at <http://www.sugarcreek.k12.oh.us/CollegeCreditPlus.aspx>. At the completion of the parent night you will be provided a code.
- Step 2:** Complete the [Intent to Participate Google Form](#) by **April 1st!** You will need the code provided at the CCP Parent Information Night. No late forms will be accepted.
- Step 3:** Apply online! Complete the application at <https://www.wright.edu/college-credit-plus/enrollment-process> and ask Mrs. Scohy to submit your transcripts. The college will notify you about acceptance with either an email or mailed letter. Application Deadline: May 1st.
- Step 4:** Students must meet college requirements to enroll for credit. Each university sets their own requirements for admission. You will have to take the college placement test unless you have adequate ACT/SAT scores.
 - CCP State Eligibility Requirements:
 - For Math courses:
 - For MTH 1280, a score of 22 or above on the ACT mathematics examination, 550 or above on the SAT mathematics examination, or a score of 46 or better on the Wright State ALEKS mathematics examination
 - A score of 18 or above on the ACT English examination, or a score of 490 or above on the SAT Reading and Writing examinations, or a score of 84 or above on the Wright State writing placement examination
 - For English Composition
 - A score of 21 or above on the ACT English examination, or a score of 550 or above on the SAT Reading and Writing examinations, or a score of 86 or above on the Wright State writing placement examination
 - For Science and Engineering Courses
 - A score of 22 or above on the ACT mathematics examination, 550 or above on the SAT mathematics examination, or a score of 46 or above on the Wright State ALEKS mathematics examination

- A score of 18 or above on the ACT English examination, or a score of 490 or above on the SAT Reading and Writing examinations, or a score of 84 or above on the Wright State writing placement examination
 - For Humanities, Social Sciences, Fine Arts and Languages Courses
 - A score of 18 or above on the ACT English examination, or a score of 490 or above on the SAT Reading and Writing examinations, or a score of 84 or above on the Wright State writing placement examination
 - Students with a learning disability, medical condition, sensory impairment, psychological condition (including ADD/ADHD) or have an IEP or 504 in high school, should contact the Office of Accessibility for help with completing placement testing by calling 937-775-5680.
 - **Placement testing for WSU students *might* be offered at BHS on the following days: May 11th at 6 pm and May 19th at 1:30 pm.**
 - If you are unable to test at BHS, then you will be responsible for scheduling a placement test at WSU. You can register by revisiting your Admissions Portal at <https://wright.force.com/>. Log-in to your portal by using the email and password you used when you applied. Once logged in, check the "**Explore Majors and Programs**" section. In this section, you first need to set up your Wright State computer accounts. To do this, click "**Access your Student Portal**" and follow the on-screen instructions.
- Step 5:** If taking classes at Wright State University, you must contact Wright State's University College at (937) 775-5750 regarding registration appointments to schedule an advising and registration appointment.
- Step 6:** Any students taking classes at Wright State University must meet with Mrs. Scohy to review schedule before August 7th. Email khris.scohy@bss.k12.oh.us to schedule an appointment time.

All steps must be complete by August 7th to be enrolled in the CCP course.
