STATE TESTING REQUIREMENTS – CLASSES OF 2023 AND BEYOND

For students who enter grade 9 on or after July 1, 2019, state testing laws require districts to administer end-of-course tests to all students at the completion of the associated course.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate from Bellbrook High School, the student must fulfill ALL credit and course requirements and meet the requirements of Ohio's End of Course Exams or Alternate Pathway. Ohio Graduation Requirements. See Bellbrook Graduation Plan Form.

Minimum of **24 credits** and meet the following requirements:

Minimum of **22 credits** and meet the following requirements:

Credit is only earned at the successful completion of a semester course or year-long course. Partial credit will not be granted for year-long courses.

COMPETENCY & ALTERNATIVES

To graduate, students must earn a "competency" score on ELA II and Algebra I EOC tests or complete other options. Remediation and retakes are offered before alternative pathways.

INDUSTRY-RECOGNIZED CREDENTIAL SEAL

Earn an approved industry-recognized credential that is aligned to a job considered in demand in this state and its regions.



MILITARY ENLISTMENT SEAL

Provide evidence that a student has enlisted in a branch of the U.S. Armed Forces; or Participate in an approved JROTC program

CITIZENSHIP SEAL

A student can:


1. 3+ on US Hist and US Gov EOC,
2. Passing grade on AP or IB, or
3. “B” or higher in appropriate classes taken through CCP.



SCIENCE SEAL

A student can:

1. 3+ on the Biology EOC,
2. Passing grade on AP or IB, or
3. “B” or higher in a HS advance science class or in an appropriate class taken through CCP.



HONORS DIPLOMA SEAL

A student can:

1. Academic Honor Diploma
2. International Baccalaureate Honors Diploma
3. Career-Tech Honors Diploma
4. STEM Honors Diploma
5. Arts Honors Diploma
6. Social Science and Civic Engagement Honors Diploma



TECHNOLOGY SEAL

A student can:

1. Passing score on AP or IB test,
2. “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus program;
or
3. Complete a HS course that meets guidelines developed by the ODE.



COMMUNITY SERVICE & STUDENT ENGAGEMENT SEALS

COMMUNITY SERVICE SEAL (LOCAL)

In order to earn the BHS Community Service Seal a student must complete a minimum of 30 hours of documented community service. Community service hours must be verified and turned in by May 1st of your graduating year.



STUDENT ENGAGEMENT SEAL (LOCAL)

In order to earn the BHS Student Engagement seal a student must be an active participant in BHS and/or GCCC sponsored extracurricular activities such as athletics, JROTC, Marching Band & Color Guard, Winterguard, IPE, school clubs, or student government for all four years of high school.



FINE and PERFORMING ARTS SEAL (LOCAL)

In order to earn the BHS Fine Arts seal a student must demonstrate skill in the visual or performing arts through:



PERFORMING ARTS


Active participation in a voice, instrumental, and/or theatrical performance during at least three years of the student's high school career. Example activities may include Marching Band, Concert Band, Choir, IPE, Color/Winter Guard, DPYO, Honor Band, school and/or community

plays/musicals, or other pre-approved activities. Students will be required to submit verification of participation in any activity completed outside of Bellbrook High School.



VISUAL ARTS

Active participation in the BHS Art program culminating in the completion of an Art 4 portfolio or enter works into a local or regional art show at least three years of the student's high school career. Examples could include works displayed in the district art festival/show or another local or regional festival/show or a piece of art recognized in a local or regional art contest, or other pre-approved activities. Students will be required to submit verification of participation in any activity completed outside of Bellbrook High School.
