How to Submit Your Graduation Plan

As part of the pathway to <u>Ohio's Graduation Requirements</u>, students must show that they have completed all three parts:

- 1. Credit Requirements
- 2. Competency
- 3. Readiness

You will complete a graduation plan, looking at this criteria. To complete your grad plan, first take a look at your unofficial transcript.

You will see some personalized information on your transcript:

- Attendance
- GPA (unweighted and weighted)
- EOC Test Scores
- Course History View your completed courses and total credits earned

You must earn 24 credits to graduate with an advanced diploma. Use the information on your unofficial transcript to mark the checkboxes with your completed classes.

Are you working towards an honors diploma? Take a look at the criteria to see what you need.

My Competency


You must earn a passing score on the ELA 2 and Algebra 1 EOC tests (must score 684 or higher). If you do not earn a passing score, you will retest at least one time before choosing an alternate pathway. If you have passed the ALG 1 and ELA 2 test with a 684 or higher, mark the appropriate checkboxes.

My Readiness

You must earn two seals. Click on the seal below for information about each seal. You will check the appropriate checkbox if you have completed the criteria for earning a seal.







My Plan to Show Competency and Readiness

As part of your plan, you will mark how you plan to show competency and readiness.

Competency: Most of you will earn a passing score on the ELA II and ALG 1 tests so mark the checkbox saying you plan to "earn a passing score on the ELA II and ALG I EOC tests.

Readiness: You must earn two seals, however, you can earn more. Mark the checkbox for any seal you plan to earn.
