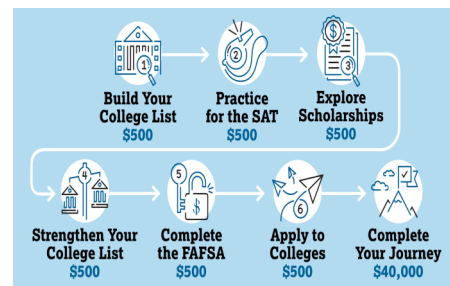

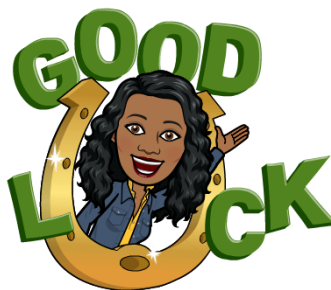
## The American Legion High School Oratorical Scholarship

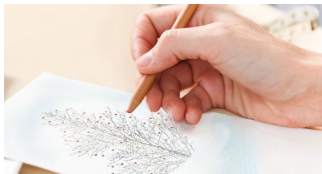

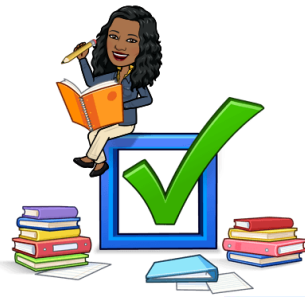
