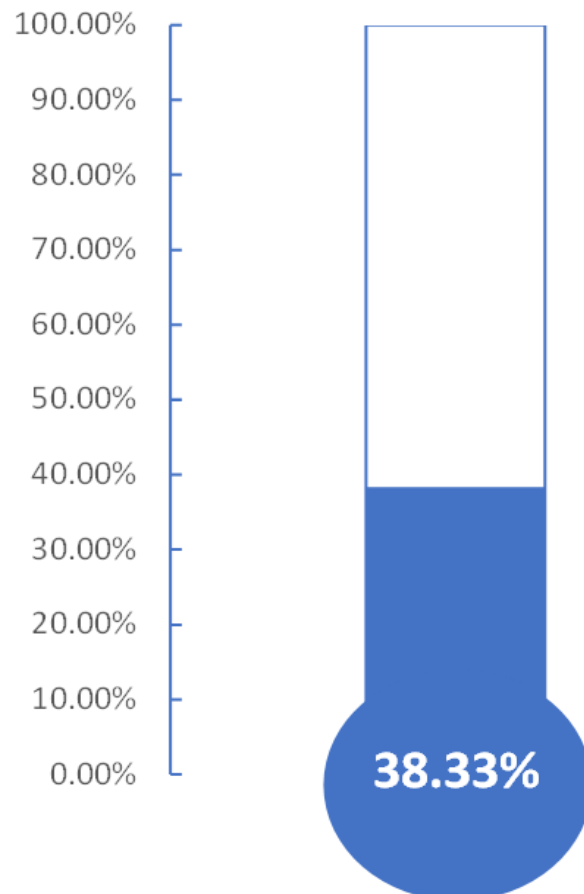

Financial Aid professionals will be at BHS to help parents and students complete the FAFSA application.

WHY???? To maximize your chances of qualifying for aid, you must submit your FAFSA application as soon as possible. You are more likely to qualify for federal, state, and college-offered grants/scholarships if you file the FAFSA early.

Completing your FAFSA now, will allow colleges the ability to use that information to produce your financial aid award letter. Having a financial aid award letter will make comparing colleges much easier, as you can quickly compare what each school's cost will be after applying grants and scholarship awards.

The FAFSA application usually takes approximately an hour and a half, that's if you have all the required documentation. Below is a list.

- **Personal Documentation Needed:**
 1. Student Social Security number
 2. Parent(s) Social Security numbers if you are a dependent student
 3. Student driver's license number, if applicable
 4. Student Alien Registration number, if not a U.S. Citizen
- **Financial Information:**
 1. Your Social Security number (*it is important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA form*)
 2. Your driver's license number if you have one
 3. Federal tax information or tax returns including IRS W-2 information, for you (and your spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are a dependent student:
 - a. IRS 1040
 - b. Foreign tax return, IRS 1040NR, or IRS 1040NR-EZ
 4. Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans noneducation benefits, for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
 5. Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate (but not including the home in which you live); and business and farm assets for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student

When completing the FAFSA Application— Please remember.....

- ♦ **Both** you and your parent/guardian will need a **FSA ID**
- ♦ You will need your parents 2021 Tax Information
- ♦ You will need to complete the 2023-2024 application.

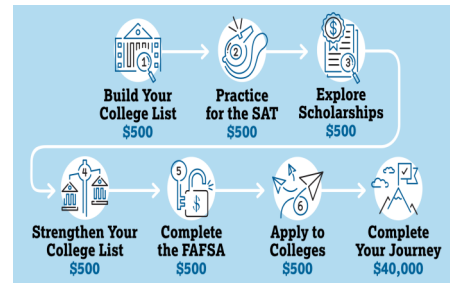

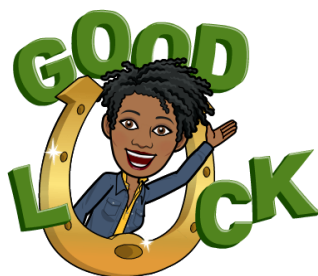
